Help Lesotho

Help Lesotho is an international development organisation, which aims to foster a sense of hope and motivation in those who are most in need by targeting root causes and community priorities.

FACET has worked with Help Lesotho since 2008, when it partnered with the charity to build the first Graff Leadership Centre in Lesotho with the aim of providing a home and education for Basotho orphan girls and supporting the wider community.




It is estimated that approximately 1,000 children in Africa are orphaned each and every day.

Today the Centre hosts a residential Leadership
Programme for 50 high-risk, vulnerable girls. Each
participant is enrolled on courses to improve literacy,
employability and leadership skills and to tackle health
issues around HIV and self-esteem.



The Centre also runs programmes incorporating over 150 activities for local residents, ranging from teenagers to grandmothers, including anti-AIDS clubs, sixday leadership camps and three-day gender conferences, aimed at both women and men.

Hosting computer and leadership training, job and life skills tutoring and income generating activities, the Centre has directly benefited more than 510 orphans, vulnerable children and their caregivers with outreach to a total of over 6,500 individuals.

The Centre's groundbreaking 'Finding The Leader Within Programme' empowers youngsters, primarily those who are orphaned and vulnerable to attain employment, sustain a high quality of life and become productive members of society.





FACET is extremely grateful to its trustees and donors who make funding possible.

Pebbles Project works within South Africa's Winelands to enrich the lives of children from disadvantaged backgrounds and youngsters with special educational needs, in particular those whose lives are affected by alcohol.

FACET is delighted to announce its partnership with Pebbles Project which will see the launch of the first Graff Mobile Learning Centres in mid 2014.



Two Learning Centres will support a total of 11 farms, which in turn will benefit over 1,200 children and adults in the region.



Travelling around the Winelands, the Graff Mobile Learning Centres will provide after-school maths and reading tuition with a new range of computer facilities and reading materials.

A book borrowing facility will also enable children to practice their skills at home, while a games and DVD library aims to foster a sense of family unity through encouraging families to engage in positive activities together.
