Description

Tsitsikamma Village Inn, located in the village of Storms River on the beautiful Garden Route, offers a unique form of accommodation. Most of our rooms are situated around a typical Village green. These buildings represent many of the different building styles that were to be found in the Cape Colony during the 1800's.

The Oude Martha Restaurant serves hearty and delicious breakfasts, lunches and dinners. Other popular on-site restaurants include the characterful Hunter's Pub and the informal Cafe Bacchus. Next door to the hotel, is the Marilyn's 60s Diner, where you'll enjoy a trip down memory lane with the vintage motorcycles, cars, memorabilia and a typical diner menu. Enjoy an Ale in our microbrewery which also offers a number of other South African craft beers.

Our hotel is a great base from which to explore the natural attractions and adventure options of the region and there are many ways to do this from hiking trails, mountain biking and horse rides to tree-top canopy tours and bungee jumping. Between excursions, guests are welcome to relax around the sparkling swimming pool or entertain themselves in the games room. There is complimentary wi-fi available throughout the hotel. In-room facilities include air-conditioning/heating, electrical blankets, television and a tea/coffee station.

Accommodation:

More magic has been added to the Garden Route where we have re-constructed a typical Cape Village of the past, and where old traditions of warmth and hospitality thrive side-by-side with all the comforts of the modern day. This historic South African hotel has served as a stop-over for travellers for more than a century. Visitors can delve into the past and select their home in a typical Cape Village.

This unique village reflects all colonial building styles that can be found in South Africa's famous garden route. You can opt for a sojourn in the imposing Cape Dutch style, the Drostdy or the Landdrost's (magistrate's) house, or you can choose to stay in one of the charming Victorian forester's cottages, in a quaint fisherman's cottage or a simple Karoo Pastorie (pastor's home) with its deep stoep and sash windows, a humble barn, a honeymoon room, or rustic log chalets. Each cottage has its own individual garden that matches the specific style of gardening reminiscent to each individual colonial building style. Each room is tastefully decorated in the appropriate style for the period.



Accommodation Types

Premier Rooms:

- De Oude Pastorie x 4
A double-storey 'flat-roofed' house is a very typical feature of southern cape villages, with sash windows
- Albert & Victoria Honeymoon Cottage x 2
This decorative building is late-Victorian, with sash windows

Village Rooms:

- Hanover, Drostdy, Ikaya, Arniston and the Victorian Cottages x 20 (4 x family rooms)
The 'village square' is made up of replicas of traditional buildings of the earlier building styles of the Cape Colony and is decorated accordingly.

Barn Rooms x 7:

The Barn, built in the late 1800's as stables for travellers horses, was converted in 1996 to cosy bedrooms.

Log Rooms:

- WEST - double storey wooden rooms x 8 (4 x family rooms)
 - EAST - double storey wooden rooms x 8 (2 x family rooms)
- Wooden chalets built in 1988, around its own village square
