The camp is approximately six hours by road from Johannesburg, following the recommended route via Polokwane and Tzaneen. Secure parking is available at the Olifants West Entrance Gate, where our guide will meet you with an open game viewer to transfer you to the camp.

- **Accommodation:** Four en-suite safari tents, ideal for guests seeking a classic explorer-style safari with subtle modern comforts. Each tent is furnished with twin beds that can be converted into a king-size configuration.
- **Bathrooms:** Each tent features a full en-suite bathroom equipped with a bucket shower, with hot water available on request, allowing guests to enjoy a traditional safari-style bathing experience. The bathrooms also include flushing toilets and running cold water.
- **Comfort:** For added comfort, all tents are fitted with a fan, ensuring a cool and pleasant environment during warmer bushveld days and nights. Each tent also offers a private deck with outdoor furniture, providing a peaceful space to relax and enjoy the surrounding bush.
- **Plunge Pool:** A refreshing plunge pool, offering the perfect retreat on warm afternoons, with a view of the waterhole where wildlife often comes to drink.
- **Sustainability:** In our commitment to environmental conservation, the camp is entirely powered by solar energy. To maintain eco-friendly operations, hairdryers are not permitted on the premises.
- **Dining Area:** An interactive open-plan kitchen and dining area, providing a communal space for guests to enjoy delicious meals.
- **Viewing Deck:** A multi-level deck with a plunge pool and lounge, offering stunning views of the watering hole and surrounding area—ideal for relaxation and socializing.
- **Boma:** A traditional boma fire, creating a magical ambiance for evening gatherings under the African stars.
- **Guest Toilet:** A conveniently located guest toilet alongside the viewing deck.
- **Underground Hide:** Get closer to nature with a unique experience at the underground hide, located near the water hole for exceptional wildlife viewing.

- **Disconnect & Recharge** – Experience a true digital detox at our remote camp, where mobile signal and Wi-Fi are limited. The camp's secluded location means connectivity may be intermittent or inconsistent, especially during load-shedding, allowing you to fully disconnect and immerse yourself in the natural surroundings.
- **Wi-Fi Access:** There is limited Wi-Fi available at Bundox Explorer camp; The lodge is currently exploring satellite connectivity options for future use
- **Electricity:** The camp operates on a sustainable solar-powered system, providing mains electricity (220V).
- **Charging Facilities:** Charging stations for electronic devices are conveniently located in the safari lounge. Please note that charging points are not available in the tents.

### SEASONS & CLOTHING

When visiting our lodges in the Kruger National Park area, it's important to pack appropriately for the season to ensure your comfort during your stay. Always bring a hat, sunglasses, and sunscreen to protect against the strong African sun, even in cooler months.

- Neutral-toned clothing is ideal for game drives and walking safaris, allowing you to blend into the natural environment.
- Comfortable walking shoes are recommended year-round.
- For evenings, smart-casual attire is appropriate if dining at the lodge's restaurant or enjoying special occasions.
- Spring (1 September - 30 November): Expect warm days and cool evenings. Lightweight clothing is ideal for the daytime, with a light jacket for cooler mornings and evenings.
- Summer (1 December - 28 February): Summer temperatures can reach between 30-40°C. Pack cool, light, and comfortable clothing, as well as a swimming costume to enjoy the lodge's pool facilities. This is also the rainy season, so an umbrella or lightweight raincoat is recommended.
- Autumn (1 March - 31 May): Temperatures begin to cool slightly, making it ideal for outdoor activities. Pack a mix of summer and light autumn wear for layering as needed. Winter (1 June - 31 August): Winter days are mild and sunny, but evenings and early mornings can be chilly. Warm layers, including jackets, jerseys, and socks, are essential for early game drives or outdoor dining experiences.

### CONSERVATION AND BED LEVIES

A safari in Africa offers a privileged opportunity to experience wildlife in its natural habitat, and this experience is closely linked to the conservation efforts that sustain these ecosystems. By participating in a safari, you become an active participant in these efforts, contributing to the preservation of Africa's unique wildlife and ensuring future generations can continue to enjoy these wonders.

In line with neighboring reserves, we have significantly enhanced our anti-poaching strategies, requiring substantial investment.


Our primary goal is to protect vulnerable species, including rhinos, that call this region home. To support these ongoing efforts, all reservations include applicable conservation and/or bed levies.

The conservation levy, charged per person, per night or per stay (depending on the camp), is crucial in maintaining the reserve's pristine condition. These funds support a range of critical initiatives, including anti-poaching measures, road maintenance, invasive plant eradication, and fire break management.

The bed levy contributes to infrastructure maintenance within the reserve, ensuring well-maintained roads, and trails, that support a safe and enjoyable experience while minimizing environmental impact. Part of the bed levy also funds conservation education programs that raise awareness and foster a sense of responsibility towards preserving the region's natural heritage. At Bundox, we are committed to the conservation of parks and reserves, the protection of wildlife, and the well-being of local communities. Your contribution through these levies plays a crucial role in the longterm sustainability of this remarkable ecosystem, and we deeply appreciate your support in these vital efforts.

## A DAY ON SAFARI AT Bundox Explorer Camp

Experience a sample day in the bush, with timings that may vary depending on the season and wildlife activity.

05:00	Wake up call
05:30	Quick coffee
09:00	Depart for morning game drive with coffee stop
10:00-13:00	Enjoy the morning at leisure or sit in underground hide
13:00	Head down to the main area for lunch
16:30	Afternoon game drive with sundowners
19:00	Dinner and chatter around the campfire in the boma area

## MALARIA

- The Lowveld region is considered a low-risk malaria area. We recommend consulting your local doctor or travel clinic for personalised advice regarding malaria prevention.
- If prophylactic medication is advised for the Kruger area, commonly recommended options include Malarone, Doxycycline, or Mefloquine.
- Mosquitoes are most prevalent during the wet, warmer months, so in addition to medication, we recommend using mosquito repellent, creams, and other protective measures.
- For your comfort and safety, the lodge is regularly sprayed by a professional pest control specialist.
