Originally built in 1992 by artists Tonio and Anna Trzebinski as a family home, Hemingways Eden Residence has evolved into a deeply personal retreat. Now part of the Hemingways Collection, the property blends warm Kenyan hospitality with the quiet polish of international standards, offering a uniquely immersive and character-rich stay. Set within a lush forested enclave, Hemingways Eden Residence invites guests into a world where art, nature and culture meet in perfect harmony.

Surrounded by one hundred acres of indigenous forest, the residence feels intimately connected to the wild. Guests fall asleep to the calls of hyena and bush babies, and wake to the chorus of over two hundred species of birds. Step inside, and that sense of wonder continues through curated interiors, original artworks, and hand-picked furnishings that reflect a life well travelled. Whether relaxing in the light-filled lounges, browsing the on-site concept store, or simply enjoying a quiet breakfast on the veranda, every space feels inspiring and deeply restful.







Perfectly positioned in Langata, Hemingways Eden Residence is just thirty minutes from Jomo Kenyatta International Airport and fifteen minutes from Wilson Airport, with private transfers easily arranged. The location offers effortless access to some of Nairobi's most iconic experiences, from Nairobi National Park and the Sheldrick Wildlife Trust to the Karen Blixen Museum and Giraffe Centre. With the city's best restaurants, galleries, and artisan boutiques close by, Hemingways Eden Residence is a sanctuary for those seeking both creative energy and quiet escape.

For those wanting to be closer to the outdoors, the Forest and Garden Rooms open directly to the surrounding landscape, looking out over the Giraffe Sanctuary Forest or the residence's herb garden. Nestled in the leafy grounds, the three airy studio lofts, with generous windows and two-level layouts, offer extra space and independence, making them ideal for longer stays or for families seeking room to spread out.

Completing the collection, the private Cottage blends charm and seclusion with a cosy living area, kitchenette, and king bedroom, perfect for couples seeking a more intimate hideaway.

Across all spaces, guests enjoy thoughtful amenities, deep soaking tubs or rain showers, and a sense of staying in a home filled with creativity, warmth, and connection to nature.

# Activities

Explore Nairobi National Park, where lions, rhinos, and giraffes roam freely against the dramatic city skyline, or enjoy close up encounters with endangered Rothschild giraffes at the nearby Giraffe Centre. At the Sheldrick Wildlife Trust, rescued baby elephants offer an unforgettable window into Kenya's conservation efforts.

Guests can take a guided nature walk through the indigenous Giraffe Sanctuary Forest, where Hemingways Eden Residence is tucked away.

Beneath towering acacias, listen for birdsong and spot monkeys among the trees as you reconnect with nature.

For those drawn to the arts, Nairobi's creative energy is vibrant and ever evolving. Discover contemporary exhibitions at Circle Art Gallery, meet local artisans and designers, and explore handcrafted pieces at the nearby Utamaduni Craft Centre. At Hemingways Eden Residence's own concept store, the Artisanal Gallery, guests can browse a thoughtfully curated collection of Kenyan fashion, homeware, and accessories, each piece crafted by leading local designers and makers, offering an opportunity to take home a meaningful expression of Kenyan creativity.

You can also step into literary history with a visit to the Karen Blixen Museum, one of Nairobi's most iconic landmarks.

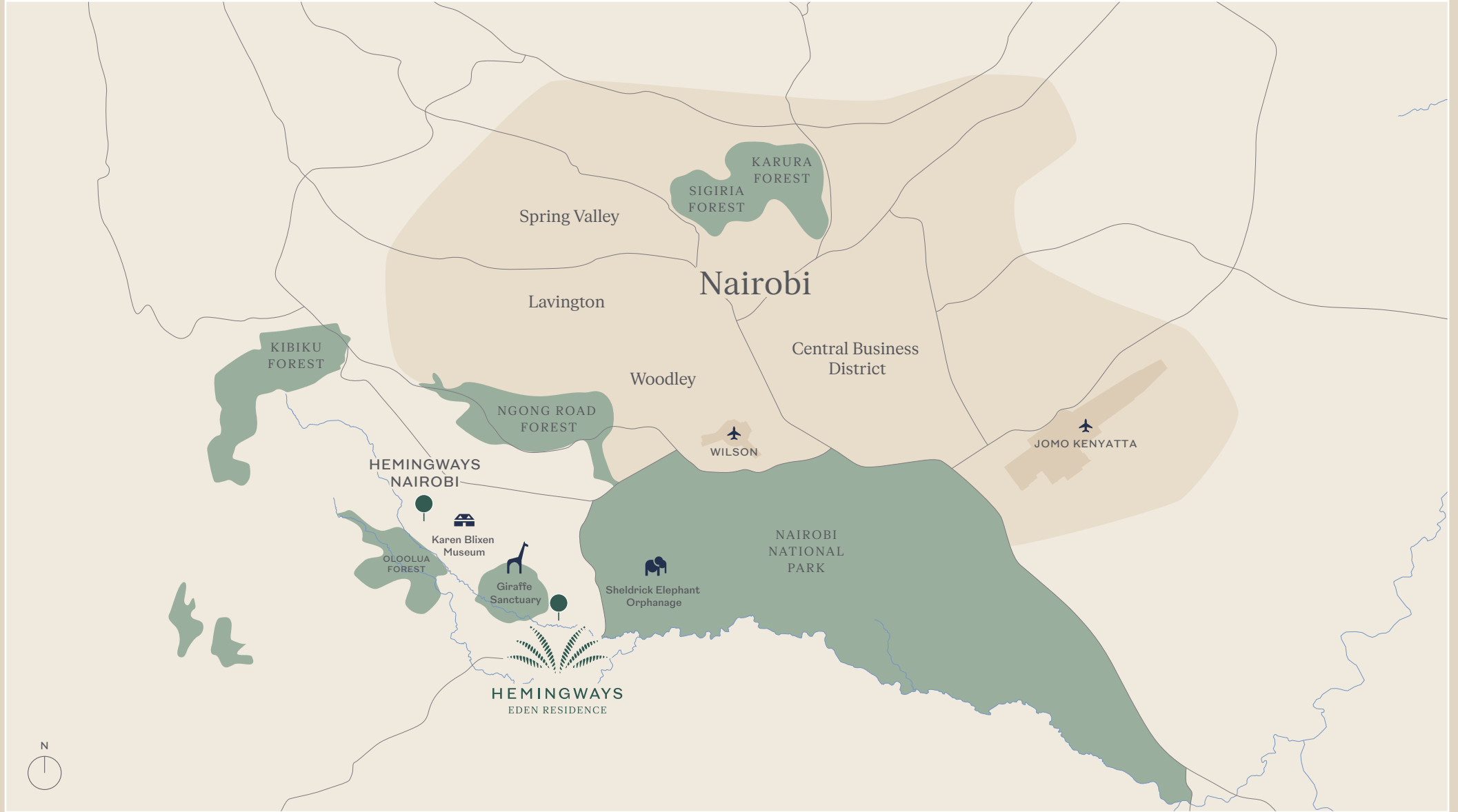
