



**4 NIGHTS SAFARI:
3 NIGHTS CAMEL SAFARI PLUS TUMAREN CAMP**

A unique walking safari staying in three idyllically remote campsites with camels transporting the whole camp to a new location each day and ending with a night at the beautiful Tumaren Camp. Exploring a variety of country and the largest diversity of large mammals in Kenya.

Walking Level: Easy - Moderate 8-12km per day



Day 1- Nayasura

Our safari will begin at the breathtaking Nayasura, a magnificent rock kopje that has likely been used as a shelter or campsite for millennia, evident from the stone chippings and ancient, pre-Maasai graves. Upon arrival, our guests will be treated to a mouth-watering lunch before settling into their tents. After a post-lunch rest we will then embark on a wildlife walk, taking in the sights and sounds of the African bush. Our afternoon journey will culminate at the peak of Nayasura, where we will sip sundowners and marvel at the spectacle of baboons returning to roost. After an exhilarating day, we will return to camp for refreshing hot showers before unwinding with drinks around the campfire. The evening will conclude with a sumptuous sit-down dinner under the starry African sky.






Day 2- Nyarara

Following an energizing breakfast, we will set off towards our next destination, Nyarara, located to the north. The campsite's namesake is a magnificent male cheetah, who had been frequently seen in the area and comes from the Masai word for cheetah. Our journey will take us across vast open plains and through dense acacia bush, providing opportunities to spot an array of wildlife, including Impala, Zebra, Giraffe, Elephant, and more. If we're lucky, a predator like a Leopard, Lion or Hyena. While our pack camels transport the camp via a shorter route, our riding camels will accompany us and can be ridden at any time.

After a refreshing lunch, we will have the afternoon to unwind before embarking on an evening stroll to a stunning sundowner spot. Afterwards, we will then return to camp for a delicious dinner, recounting the day's adventures under the starry African sky.

Day 3 - River Camp

As we savor an early morning breakfast, we set out towards our next campsite, nestled along the banks of the Ewaso River. This vital water source in Northern Kenya sustains a diverse range of wildlife and runs along the edge of the Laikipia Plateau. Our journey will take us through a varied landscape, from expansive plains to thick mixed bush, allowing us to walk amongst a diverse array of wildlife. Back at camp, we'll have the chance to take a refreshing dip in the river to cool off before enjoying a well-deserved lunch. As the day begins to cool, we will wander up the river, observing animals that come to drink, finding sundowners along the way and on return, a delectable dinner under the magnificent African sky.





Day 4 - Tumaren Camp

Set before the towering hillside of Loseramaru, this Tumaren boasts unparalleled views of the surrounding open plain, where wildlife can often be spotted wandering in the distance.

The camp's large, airy mess areas overlook a nearby waterhole, providing ample opportunities for incredible sightings of majestic herds of Elephant, Giraffe, Zebra, and Warthog, who frequently come to visit. Each spacious sleeping tent offers a comfortable king-size bed, with family tents featuring one or two additional single beds, as well as an ensuite bathroom and an outdoor seating area, perfect for soaking in the spectacular views. The pool and the poolhouse also offer a great place to not only relax but to also view the passing game on the way to the waterhole in front of camp.
