The story of Auberge Safari is one of shared vision and a deep-rooted love for Africa. What began as two independent operators' commitment to protect Tanzania's natural heritage has evolved into something bigger: a shared collection of world-class lodges and luxury tented camps that showcase some of East Africa's most iconic landscapes.

Our collection of properties spans the northern Tanzania safari circuit, from sought-after locales within the Serengeti National Park to prime positions within our two exclusive-use protected wildlife areas. Our protected areas — one, a thriving wildlife corridor linking the Tarangire and Manyara national parks, the other, a vast area bordering both the southern Serengeti and the Ngorongoro Conservation Area — open up swathes of wilderness for more intimate exploration away from the bustle of the national parks.

With Auberge Safari, the wild unfolds on its own terms. Our privately guided journeys are shaped entirely around you, allowing for deeper, more intentional



experiences. Here, every moment invites connection with the rhythms of the land — from elephant encounters that unfold without rush to the Great Migration's adrenaline-pumping Mara River crossings.

This sense of freedom is guided by our pioneering Slow Safari philosophy — an invitation to slow down, attune to nature, and savor each moment in the Tanzanian wilderness. Days unfold at your own pace, with the space to experience as much — or as little — as you choose, creating time for meaningful connection with both place and people.

# Conservation and community impact

Protecting the Wild, Empowering People

Auberge Safari sits at the intersection of travel, conservation, and community. Every journey directly supports the protection of Tanzania's wilderness and the well-being of the people who call it home.

Through partnerships with the Friedkin Conservation Fund and the Chem Chem Association, we help restore ecosystems, safeguard wildlife, and create lasting opportunities for local communities.

## **FRIEDKIN CONSERVATION FUND (FCF) A Key Force in Tanzanian Conservation**

The Friedkin Conservation Fund manages three ecologically significant wilderness areas that together form the Greater Mwiba Protected Wildlife Area — a vital buffer to the Serengeti and Ngorongoro ecosystems, spanning over 2,000 km<sup>2</sup>.

This landscape plays a critical role in protecting the Great Migration, particularly during calving season, which unfolds amid the short grass plains. Alongside

conservation, FCF invests in education, healthcare, and infrastructure, while creating employment opportunities for surrounding communities. By ensuring that local people benefit directly from conservation, the long-term protection of this ecosystem is secured.

## **CHEM CHEM ASSOCIATION (CCA) Restoring a Vital Wildlife Corridor**

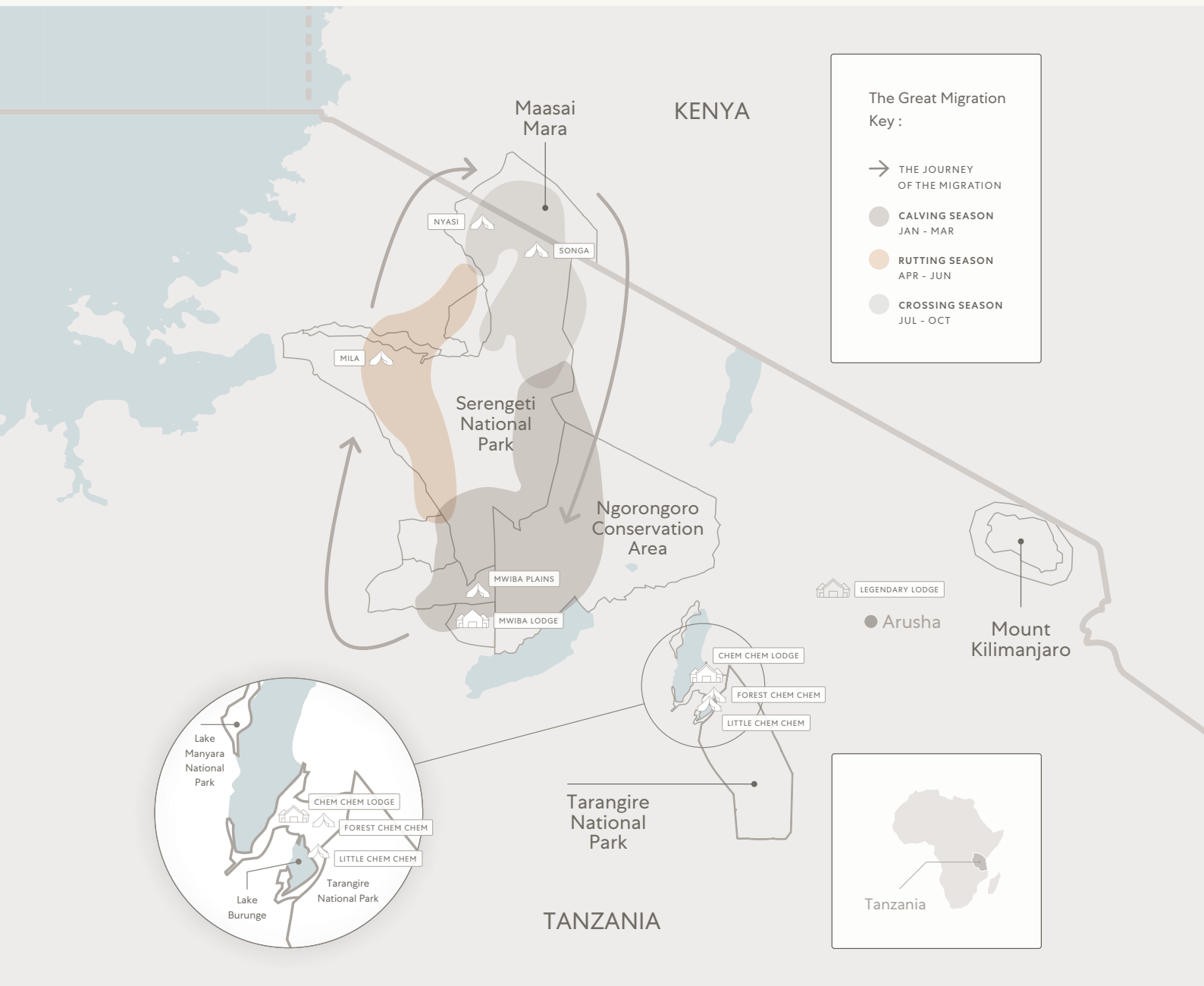
The Chem Chem Association focuses on protecting the Kwakuchinja Wildlife Corridor, which reconnects Tarangire and Lake Manyara National Parks. Once declared abandoned, this critical migratory route has been successfully restored into a thriving ecosystem.

Today, it supports the movement of key species, including elephants and lions, while strengthening both environmental and community resilience. Working closely with neighboring villages, CCA invests in education, healthcare, and livelihood development — linking high-end, low-impact tourism with tangible conservation and community benefits.
