



GETTING MARRIED IN PERU

Resident foreigners can get married in Peru. There are three main steps before a marriage can go ahead:

- Registration of intent to marry and presentation of the relevant documents
- · Publication of the banns
- Issue of marriage license

Non-residents who wish to travel to Cusco to marry will need to have the following documents certified at the Peruvian consulate in their home country:

- · Original birth certificate
- Proof of single status
- Proof of residence in the foreign country (utility bills)
- Photocopy of passport

All documents need to be apostilled or authenticated at the Peruvian embassy or consulate.

ELIGIBLE WEDDING LOCATIONS

The marriage ceremony can take place in any function room in the hotel, as long as the local registry office has been informed of the address, date and time, and has agreed to send an official to conduct the ceremony.
