

10 x single bedroom cottages

En-suite cottages

Double, twin, or triple configurations.

Interconnecting options may be available; however, prior booking is required. This is an ideal option for families or friends traveling together (up to 3 guests).

2 x 2 bedroom cottages

Perfect for families or friends travelling together.

Kahawa cottage can accommodate up to 4 guests. Meru cottage can accommodate up to 5 guests.

Bed configurations

King / Twin

King (210x200cm) or twin (200x110cm) bed configurations are available.

A cot can be arranged for children up to 2 years (subject to availability; booking prior to arrival is required).

5 x extra beds

Triple rooming can be arranged. Inquire for availability. Booking prior to arrival is required. Max 5 extra single beds available at the lodge for children up to 15 years (except in Kahawa cottage).

Children policy

All ages are welcome.

Each cottage features a bath and a separate indoor shower.

LOCATION AND ACCESS



Location

On the grounds of a working coffee estate on the outskirts of Arusha, Tanzania.

Access and transfers

Arusha Airport and town	±15 minutes' drive from the lodge — transfers included.		
Kilimanjaro Int. Airport	±90 minutes' drive from the lodge (transfer at additional charge).		
Lake Manyara NP	2 hours by road or 25-minute flight to LKY (transfer at additional charge).		
Tarangire NP	2 hours by road or 25-minute flight to Kuro (transfer at additional charge).		
Arusha NP	1 hour 45 mins by road (transfer at additional charge).		
Ngorongoro Conservation Area	4 hours by road (transfer at additional charge).		



Opening dates

The lodge is open year-round, with the exception of a short break between April 1 and 30.

Available by arrangement. Booking prior to arrival is essential.

Weather

Warm temperate climate year-round.

Rainfall

The short rains are usually from mid-November to mid-January, with a wonderful, temperate climate from December to March. The long rains are between April and May, and June to mid-November is the dry season.

TRAVEL VISA

Visas are required for most countries. Please review visa arrangements, requirements, and e-services prior to arrival by visiting the Tanzanian Immigration Department's website.

MALARIA

Protection recommended — seek advice from your doctor before traveling.

MEDICAL INSURANCE

We highly recommend guests obtain medical insurance prior to arrival, with a policy cover inclusive of emergency airlift evacuation.

YELLOW FEVER

A Yellow Fever certificate is not required for Tanzania but may be required if traveling via neighboring countries.


CURRENCY

Are prohibited unless a special permit is obtained prior to arrival in the country.



Commitment to

Core to the Friedkin Conservation Fund Tanzania's (FCFT) mission is the ongoing protection of Tanzania's natural heritage. As the conservation and philanthropic arm of Legendary Expeditions, FCFT is responsible for safeguarding 2 vast wilderness areas that form vital buffer zones to the Greater Serengeti and Ngorongoro Crater ecosystems. To do this, FCFT engages the communities that share the land with us as partners in conservation and collaborates with stakeholders in effective wildlife management and research.

Community empowerment is the cornerstone of FCFT's work. This includes implementing initiatives aimed at education, improving health, and providing training in sustainable income-generating opportunities in the communities that neighbor our protected wildlife areas. In doing this, FCFT aims to uplift these communities and encourage them to see the benefits of protecting these ecosystems. This, combined with conservation projects such as anti-poaching, wildlife monitoring, and habitat management, enables FCFT to make a tangible impact in its efforts to protect this vital wilderness.
