DESCRIPTION

CHAMPAGNE

LAURENT PERRIER BRUT

Champagne. Intense and complexe on the nose, with a wide range of aromas, including citrus and white fruit and flowers, such as honeysuckle.

CHAMPAGNE

MOET & CHANDON BRUT

Champagne. Flavours of butter and brioche and a high concentration of candied fruit, ginger bread and vanilla. A champagne to savour, leaving behind a sense of harmony and mellowness with peach and nectarine lingering.

CHAMPAGNE

TAITTINGER ROSE BRUT

France. Champagne. This Champagne is a blend of some 30 Chardonnay and Pinot Noir vineyards, respectively 40% and 60% of the total, from several harvests of perfectly ripened grapes. A fine, very pure style of Champagne. Has hints of toast and citrus fruits that come together in a style that is almost the essence of Champagne. Crisp, rich and complex.

RUINART BRUT

Champagne. Lovely fine aroma and a very attractive delicate and sustained palate. Ethereal champagne with subtle bread yeast and a delicate nuttiness.

VEUVE CLICQOT BRUT

Champagne: Lingering fruity flavours of apple and pear on the palate create a fresh, harmonious and lively Champagne. It's well balanced and is pleasantly fresh.

CHAMPAGNE

KRUG GRAND CUVÉE

Champagne. Beautifully fresh aromatics, with green apple, a touch of green fig, but a lithe, creamy quality with plenty of lemony vibrancy. The palate has a very fine, crisp, vibrant mousse, with lots of life and richness, masses of lime like fruit and that very delicately nutty and spicy background. All sort so small exotic spice notes and lovely harmony and length.





CHAMPAGNE
POL ROGER PURE

Champagne. Refined nose initially revealing almonds and fresh flowers then turning to candied citrus and patisserie notes. The mouthfeel is full, mellowed and fresh, enhanced by delicate bubbles. Excellent length.

CHAMPAGNE
POL ROGER RESERVE

Champagne. Pale gold with a very fine bead; flowery, delicately toasty aroma with fruit and complexity; creamy, beautifully balanced with a dry, harmonious finish.

CHAMPAGNE
BOLLINGER SPECIAL CUVÉE

Champagne. Beautiful aromatic complexity, ripe fruit and spicy aromas, hints of roasted apples, apple compote and peaches on the nose. A subtle combination of structure, length and vivacity; bubbles like velvet; pear, brioche and spicy aromas, notes of fresh walnut.

METHODE CAP CLASSIQUE
GRAHAM BECK BLANC DE BLANC

Robertson. Rich yeasty aromas with hints of clean lime fruit on the nose. An exciting fine mousse and a creamy complexity on the palate. The wine ends with an elegant long finish.

METHODE CAP CLASSIQUE
GRAHAM BECK CHARDONNAY PINOT NOIR

Breede River. One of South Africa's benchmark bubbliels - Light yeasty aromas, good fruit on the nose, and rich creamy complexity on the palate. Fine mousse gives freshness and finesse.

METHODE CAP CLASSIQUE
STEENBERG CHARDONNAY

Constantia. The Brut 1682 is a 100% Chardonnay base made in the traditional French method and is as such designated Methode Cap Classique. The Brut 1682 has aromas of fresh granny smith apples with overtones of freshly baked biscuits, and a creamy, yet fresh, mouth feel.

METHODE CAP CLASSIQUE
SILVERTHORN ROSE

Robertson. Exotic bouquet of Turkish delight and rose water with fresh raspberries and sherbet flavours on the palate supported by a velvety texture, fine mousse and lengthy finish.



RED BLEND
ASHBOURNE

Hemel en Aarde: High toned aromas of spicy red berries, dried flowers, mint, marzipan and smoky, nutty and slightly resinous oak. Then aggressively deep in the mouth, with flavours of black raspberry, iron, leather, smoke and earth, perked up with a note of tart cranberry. This boasts terrific freshness and snappy depth of flavour. Finishes firmly tannic and impressively long.

RED BLEND
BOUCHARD FINLAYSON HANNIBAL

Hemel-en-Aarde. The composition and make up of Hannibal is unique to the Bouchard Finlayson label, and indeed South Africa. A combination of the best of France and Italy! In this bottling the blend is Sangiovese (52 %), Pinot noir (14 %), Nebbiolo (14 %), Mourvedré (10 %), Barbera (7 %) and Shiraz (3 %). This wine is tight but rich, with a core of silky sweet berry and wild plum aromas. It is beautifully textured with refined tannins arising from the bright but small harvest.

RED BLEND
CHATEAU MUSAR

Lebanon: Intense and ruby red wine. The blackcurrant flavours matched with excellent tannin and acidity balance with hints of leather and cherries coupled with tremendous richness.

RED BLEND
COLUMELLA

Swartland. Eben Sadie is widely rated as South Africa's top winemaker. He is a new world winemaker rooted in old world traditions and methods. This is a Rhone style blend, sourced from old bush vines in the Swartland. The intense, dark, smooth spicy nose has sweet, seamless pure fruit and lovely balance and complexity. The palate is dark and quite tannic with spicy red and black fruits and a rich, chocolatey character.

RED BLEND
DE TOREN FUSION V

Stellenbosch. This boutique family run winery only produces two wines and this is the flagship release, encompassing a five varietal Bordeaux style blend. Internationally acclaimed, the wine has incredible complexity, layers and layers of dark fruit, mocha, spice and an incredibly soft tannin structure. A taste of South Africa's absolute finest.

RED BLEND
DE TOREN Z

Stellenbosch. De Toren consistently produces extraordinary wines! White pepper and black olives as well as gooseberries and youngberries. Consistently rated in the 90s by Robert Parker.



RED BLEND
LAMMERSHOEK ROULETTE RED

Swartland: Typical Swartland flavours dominate the nose of this wine, the spiciness of the climate and granite based soils showing through. A rich palate is complimented by the freshness that Carignan and Grenache bring to the wine.

RED BLEND
REMHOOGTE SOARING EAGLE

Stellenbosch: Aromas of red cherries, black current, fynbos and white pepper. Berries, cherries and fresh vanilla on entry. Elegant, balanced mouthfeel with a savoury finish, lengthened by light chalky tannins.

RED BLEND
RUSTENBERG PETER BARLOW

Stellenbosch: This wine is made from 100% Cabernet Sauvignon from our very finest vineyard. It is characterized by an upfront perfume, intermingled with concentrated cassis, black cherries and some herbaceousness.

RED BLEND
RUSTENBERG JOHN MERRIMAN

Stellenbosch. This sensational Bordeaux blend is named for the Prime Minister of the Cape who purchased and revitalized part of the historical Rustenberg estate in the late 1800s. One of South Africa's most iconic bottlings, it delivers intense, smoky flavors of tobacco, cherry, licorice, and plum intertwined with complex notes of mineral and spice.

RED BLEND
SAXENBURG GUINEA FOWL

Stellenbosch. A beautiful, family run wine Estate on the Polkadraai Hills in Stellenbosch. This is a blend of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Shiraz and is an easy drinking, soft and elegant wine with complex flavours of dark fruit, spice and hints of vanilla from maturation in French and American oak.

RED BLEND
SEQUILLO

Swartland: Very clear spicy and herbal flavours and there is an underlying fresh, red fruit aroma.

CABARNET FRANC
RAINBOWS END

Stellenbosch. Damp earth and mint chocolate on nose. Lovely earthy and tea leaf flavours with black Forest cake and black cherry. Typical vegetative and herbaceous aromas with mineralic and slight floral aftertone (violets and fynbos). Intense rich fruit and juicy palate, with layers of dark chocolate and a hint of coffee.





CABARNET SAUVIGNON
PERDEBERG WINERY

Perdeberg. A deep purple Cabernet Sauvignon, showing a black berry and plummy nose. The intensity of the fruit follows through to the palate where it fills one's mouth with juicy tannins and ripe, dark fruit and hints of vanilla. The aftertaste is long and fruity.

CABARNET SAUVIGNON
TOKARA

Stellenbosch. Made by renowned South African winemaker, Miles Mossop, this wine shows intense notes of cassis, cherries and cedar with underlying hints of toasted oak, lead pencil and mint. On the palate there is a great purity of fruit, showing intense dark fruit with a hint of mocha and spice.

CABERNET FRANC
RAATS

Stellenbosch. Bruwer Raats is recognised as the leading Cabernet Franc producer in South Africa. All the grapes are sourced from Stellenbosch and grown only on decomposed dolomite granite, which gives a great acidity and freshness to the wine and adds minerality to the finish. This uber-elegant Cabernet Franc shows the stunning heights this grape can attain! It combines a core of luscious blackberry, black cherry, and plum with expressive notes of cinnamon, tobacco, coffee, and spice. Silky tannins caress the palate, and hints of dark chocolate and a great minerality. This wine has a long and supple finish.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON
BELFIELD

Elgin. The smallest wine producer in the region, at only 2.5Ha, this is truly a wine lavished with attention to detail in the vineyard and the cellar. A signature cooler climate red blend from Elgin. Low alcohol with wonderful soft tannins, dark fruit and hints of chocolate.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON
STARK CONDE

Stellenbosch. Jose Conde ensures that all of his wines are made in small batches using traditional methods. This is a characteristic Cabernet Sauvignon with lots of dark fruit, spice, dark chocolate and hints of oak. A beautiful accompaniment to an evening meal.

MERLOT
DE TRAFFORD

Stellenbosch: Pure dark red berry and cherry fruit with intriguing smokes nuts & spices and a little herbaceous character. These flavours follow through on the palate with lovely fine, dry tannins and a soft, long finish.



MERLOT
HARTENBERG

Stellenbosch: Silky and elegant with a long, lasting flavour. Expect black & red fruits, vanilla and orchards of plum.

MERLOT
VEENWOUDEN

Paarl. This dense purple coloured Merlot exhibits flavours of blackberry, raspberry, cranberry, dark chocolate and a hint of roasted coffee. It has a good underlying acidity with rich, ripe fruit, soft tannins and a lingering aftertaste.

PINOT NOIR
PAUL CLUVER SEVEN FLAGS

Elgin: This is classic Pinot noir. The nose is intriguing – first a whiff of soft dark cherries, then hints of spice. After a while, the earthy mushroom notes come through and then, finally, the perfumed oak spiciness. The palate is focused and well structured; not only by tannin, but also by balanced acidity.

PINOT NOIR
OAK VALLEY

Elgin. A family owned and run Estate for generations, Oak Valley has grown steadily in stature as a producer of limited release, cooler climate wines. Their Pinot Noir has lovely red fruit character, balanced by spice and earthy notes, making this a truly delicious wine, which will only get better with age.

PINOT NOIR
PAUL CLUVER

Elgin. Excellent colour with lots of wild berry fruit on the nose complemented by hints of chocolate, violet and coffee.

PINOTAGE
SOUTHERN RIGHT

Hemel-en-Aarde Valley. A pure, intense dark fruit perfume with a brooding, savoury, spiciness and athletic structure.

SHIRAZ
CEDERBERG

Cederberg. A powerful yet elegant Shiraz with a multitude of aromatic layers and rich concentration. Expect intense mulberry flavours layered with roasted coffee beans, dark chocolate and spice. A well-structured wine with a lingering velvet finish that will age superbly.

SHIRAZ
HARTENBERG

Stellenbosch. Hartenberg is one of the oldest and foremost producers of Shiraz in South Africa spanning some 40+ years. Saturated deep black-red colour with elegant aromas of spices, violets and berries. The palate is rich and silky with soft ripe tannins that gives structure.

SHIRAZ
MAN VINTNERS

Swartland. From selected vineyards in the Swartland region, which is the capital of Shiraz in South Africa. Showing off lovely dark fruit, spices and savoury chocolate flavours.





SHIRAZ
CONDE STARK

Jonkershoek. From a boutique producer in the beautiful Jonkershoek Valley. Dark fruit, spice, fine tannin and lovely intensity.

REISLING
PAUL CLUVER LATE HARVEST

Elgin. Made from Riesling grapes, this wine is made in the traditional noble late harvest way, allowing botrytis to set in and naturally concentrate the flavour and sugar in the grapes. The results is intense apricot and honeyed flavour with incredible fresh acidity.

WHITE BLEND
BADENHORST AA

Swartland: Perfume, spice, tea, stone fruit and citrus blossoms are some of the notes that can be detected. In the mouth the texture and ripeness and gentle tannins result in a wine that has incredible length and complex flavour profile.

WHITE BLEND
SEQUILLO

Swartland: Exotic fruit and flowery complexity on the nose. Firm texture. Subtle tannins on the palate lead to a longish aftertaste.

CHARDONNAY
CREATION

Hemel en Aarde. Straw yellow with attractive glints of green. On the nose glorious layers of sun-kissed pear and peach are enhanced by fresh minerality and a hint of piquant vanilla. The full-bodied palate is in perfect harmony: generously fruity and subtly spicy, with well-judged acidity contributing excellent balance and a lively, lingering aftertaste.

CHARDONNAY
MAN VINTNERS

Swartland. From selected vineyards in the Swartland region, particularly the cooler slopes of the renowned Perdeberg (Horse Mountain). A beautifully balanced Chardonnay with green apple, citrus and subtle buttery flavours.

CHARDONNAY
PAUL CLUVER

Elgin. The Cluver family was a pioneer in wine making in the cool Elgin valley, and their Chardonnays are world renowned. This wine shows off the lovely minerality and apple and citrus characters typical of Elgin Chardonnay, along with beautiful brioche and buttery notes from the time in French oak.

CHENIN BLANC
BADENHORST

Swartland. Made by enigmatic winemaker Adi Badenhorst, the grapes for this wine are sourced from ancient bush vines, lending incredible complexity to the final product. Absolutely delicious white wine!





CHENIN BLANC
KAAPZICHT

Stellenbosch: Ripe quince, pineapple and stone fruit, with some interesting savoury undertones. Lightly textured palate, with a hint of sweetness and balancing crunchy acid, results in a brisk finish.

CHENIN BLANC
PERDEBERG WINERY

Perdeberg. A yellow, wooded Chardonnay with a green tint and a citrus buttery nose. This ambitious wine displays a hint of vanilla and an oak flavoured well-structure backbone with fruit carrying on the palate. A rich, creamy, smooth wine.

RIESLING
HOWARD BOOYCEN

Howard Booysen is a young winemaker leading the way for transformation in the South African wine industry, having worked his way from a waiter to winemaker through his own hard work and passion. The grapes were sourced from the finest old Riesling vines from country to coast. These 25 year old (plus) vines, renders major concentration and depth. A wine laced with candy-like Mediterranean spicy nuances, coriander, lingering nectarine flavours and racing acidity.

ROSE
JORDAN

Stellenbosch. Summer-berry flavours of Shiraz combined with plummy Merlot add complexity to this dry fruity rosé.

SAUVIGNON BLANC
IONA

Elgin. On the nose high floral notes of honeysuckle, lemon zest and ruby grapefruit over-lay Iona's distinctive herbal undertones. The palate is keenly balanced showing cut green apples and lime marmalade followed by great minerality and length.

SAUVIGNON BLANC
FAIRVIEW

Darling. Fresh fig notes accompanied by bright citrus aromas on the nose. Grapefruit and subtle guava fill the palate and linger on the finish. The acidity gives good length and the mouthfeel is full, rich and textured.

SAUVIGNON BLANC
IONA, SOPHIE TE'BLANCHE

Elgin. From one of South Africa's leading Sauvignon Blanc producers, this delicious wine has floral and mineral tones with gooseberry and pear flavours.

SAUVIGNON BLANC
REYNEKE

Stellenbosch. On the nose there are pink grapefruit, lime leaf and lemon zest notes with hint of ripe gooseberries. White flower and crushed stone are abundant on the palate along with gentle citrus hints. An intense Sauvignon Blanc with a round and silken structure backed by firm acidity.





SAUVIGNON BLANC
VONDELING

Swartland. A refined nose of citrus passion fruit and fig is supported nicely by moderate capsicum freshness. The aromas on the nose carry through beautifully to a firm but fruit driven palate with a mild acidic zing, some flintiness and the lingering taste of guava.

SAUVIGNON / SEMILLION
OAK VALLEY

Elgin. This is a rich, full bodied wine with characteristics of citrus and honey. Well rounded with a lively acidity and a flinty mineral finish.

SWEET WINE
VIN DE CONSTANCE

Constantia: Very rich, smooth and ripe on the nose with aromatic sweet grape, pear, peach and apricot notes. The plate is fresh, light and open with some spice and citrus complexity. Very sweet but not heavy: a fresh style with good acidity.

VIOGNIER
LISMORE

Greyton. Rich, luscious and a bit decadent. Honeysuckle, peaches and apricot with a lingering citrus finish. A clean fresh acidity supports the extravagance of the nose and the palate.
