Going on safari with your children is one of the most transformative travel experiences shared as a family. At Angama Amboseli, children of all ages are welcome year round. We believe that connecting our young guests to the world's beautiful places and people is life-changing – not only for them, but also for the adults experiencing the wilderness and all its wonders through the eyes of their children.

Beyond safari drives, we have a wide variety of child-friendly activities on offer, to keep little ones engaged and allow parents the opportunity to relax – although they're most welcome to join in on the adventure too. These include:

- Bugging and tracking on nature walks with our Maasai Naturalists and Angama Guides who will share stories and information about the bush
- Jumping and dancing with the Maasai warriors around the Barraza



- Baking bread or making ice-cream with the Angama Amboseli Kitchen Team
- Playing soccer, cricket or mini croquet, or trying your hand at Maasai archery at the Field Games
- Learning about photography from our Angama Photographic Studio photographer, including smart-phone photography tips and editing skills
- Snuggling up in the Cheza Room with curated African books and movies, or enjoying games while looking out into Kimana Sanctuary
- Stargazing at night with toasted marshmallows around the fire
- Going on a morning 'Run with A Kenyan'
- Visiting our conservation partner, Big Life Foundation, to learn about their work to protect the Kimana eco-system and broader region
- Or simply just being together as a family — hanging by the Swimming Pool, enjoying a meal together, or learning about the wonderful African bush that surrounds you
- Painting or drawing sessions, either under the trees at The Glade while small animals scurry past, or at the Mnara overlooking elephants wandering the Sanctuary below

Children's menus are offered to our young guests for all meals. Complimentary child-minding is available between 18h00 and 22h00 daily. Angama Amboseli has two sets of interconnected suites for families travelling with children, keeping families connected while also offering parents their own space.
