

Ngorongoro Lodge





Ngorongoro Conservation Area is a protected area and a UNESCO World Heritage Site located in Ngorongoro District. A breath-taking 8.000 meter squared natural oasis.

An unforgettable 600-metredeep crater full of adventure and landscapes. More than 25,000 large animals live in the crater. Based on fossil evidence found at the Olduvai Gorge, it is known that various hominid species have occupied the area for 3 million years.

In addition to the beautiful scenery, archaeological wealth and abundant wildlife, Ngorongoro Conservation Area is also blessed with people – the Maasai – a pastoral tribe with a traditional way of life allowing them to live in harmony with the wildlife and the environment. Approximately 100,000 Maasai live in the conservation area today tending their livestock without harming wildlife.

The Maasai settle in circular-shaped villages, called boma. They are made up of huts called manyatas, which are made with bricks of materials such as adobe, straw, mud and animal dung. These components give impermeability to the walls and roof. The huts usually do not have windows but do have small skylights to let in a little light.




CRATERRIM WALKING SAFARI


The Masai is one of the main tribes of this part of Africa, well-known for keeping their pastoral traditional lifestyle. The Maasai people colonized the area thanks to their traditional way of life, which allowed them to coexist with the wildlife and the environment peacefully. Today, more than 100.000 Maasai reside in Ngorongoro Reservation Area. You will be able to visit a traditional Maasai house, the boma, where you will be able to see and participate in their cultural activities, such as the dance, house making, handcrafted ornaments and food cooking.

OLDU/AI GORGE

50\$ per person Adults & 10\$ per children aged 5 to 15.

The exhibits at the Olduvai Gorge Museum are centered around the paleoanthropological research and artifacts that have come from the surrounding area. Many of the artifacts found inside are original. The adjacent hall is dedicated solely to the Laetoli fossilized footprints.

Accompanying this are several charts and photographs describing and illustrating the process of the Laetoli Footprints creation.






CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY



The Hotel Sustainability Programme will be aligned with the corporate values of Melia Hotels International and will be offered to travellers with an interest in this part of the world as a fundamental attribute and key selling point. The company has designed a renovation project that pays special attention to protecting the natural environment, preserving culture, waste management and energy efficiency.

With a modern infrared system, the hotel manages energy consumption in the heat transmission of the machines making each of them 90% self-sufficient. In addition, 95% of the products used in the property are Km0, acquired in villages nearby. Following the example of the other properties in Tanzania, Ngorongoro Lodge will produce its own water for human consumption trough a bottling plant that will process local water and void the use of plastic transportation.
