Why Stay at Nyumbu Luxury Migration Camp:

Nyumbu Luxury Migration Camp is a small boutique semi-permanent mobile Camp with only 12 tents that aims to put our guests as close to the wildebeest migration as possible. The camp moves twice a year as it attempts to place the guests where the action is. From 15th December - 30th March the camp is Ndutu area of the NCCA, this is to try and trap the calving season of the wildebeest. During June - October the camp is pitching in the Northern part of the Serengeti, the Kogatende area with an aim of placing our guests on the front row to catch the river crossings.

The Camp offers a unique and unparalleled experience as it is not your usual mobile camp, the camp offers refined furniture and upholstery, it has permanent and solid fixture like beds, chairs etc, the camp does not operate on bucket showers but have a 24/7 hot water system piped into the tents from our solar panels.

Nyumbu Luxury migration Camp is rewriting mobile camp narrative that mobile camps must be rustic, simple with small foldable furniture, simple meals and bucket showers. Nyumbu Luxury Migration Camp is created with the trappings of luxury that have redefined the mobile camp operation in East Africa.

The Choice of the locations is not a mistake:

These two locations offer our guests the opportunity to witness the two of the greatest phenomena of the wildebeest calendar. The north offers the captivating river crossings of the crocodile infested Mara River, while the Ndutu location offers the child birth of thousands of wildebeests and zebras. These two locations pull along the predator fraternity who find easy prey and food. These therefore means that apart from plane game that would include zebras, antelopes, buffaloes, giraffes etc. We have pride of lions, cheetahs, leopards, hyenas among other predators.

The camp location in the Ndutu offers breathtaking views of the vast Savannah, untouched wilderness, and great views of Lake Masek, making it a perfect destination for wildlife enthusiasts and nature lovers. While the location in the North consists of vast grassy plains, rolling hills, rocky outcrops, and scattered acacia wood lands. The open savannah provides excellent visibility, making it easier to spot wildlife and predators that roam the area. The rivers and streams that meander through the region create pockets of lush vegetation, attracting a variety of animals and birds.

The Camp:

- 2 family tents (for 2 adults + 2 children, third child on request)

Vehicles:

- The camp has 2 open game viewers, our game package arrangement is on exclusive use of vehicle for all our guests and no mixing of guests.

The Tent:

- This is a 12 tented camp, beautifully and tastefully appointed.
- 2 permanent King bedded tents
- 6 tents can be converted into King Size, twin, single or triple.
- 2 family tents each with a King size bed and two separate beds with an adjoining lounge in between to separate the rooms. Both tents are ensuite and do not share amenities, showers or toilets.
- Triple rooms are available - triple room will have a maximum of 2 adults.
- Air condition - None
- Mosquito Nets - None
- Coffee station - available in each tent
- En-suite - All tents are en-suite with toilet and shower
- Hairdryers - Available
- Safe boxes -Available
- Internet - Yes connectivity only in the main areas
- Electric blanket - Available, especially when the camp is in Ndutu.

The Lounge and Bar tents
