Damaraland is a region of rolling plains and distant mountain ranges with rugged beautiful landscapes. It has an unusual geological feature, a wealth of rock paintings and engravings, and has a population of desert-adapted Elephants and Black Rhino combined to form a unique attraction.

With the mysterious Petrified Forest 40km away from Lodge Damaraland, and the UNESCO World Heritage Site at Twyfelfontein only 95km away, Lodge Damaraland is perfectly located for an action-packed day out in nature!

GUIDED ELEPHANT EXPERIENCE HOSTED BY TWYFELFONTEIN ELEPHANT DRIVE

- Maximum of 7 pax
- One departure daily at 07:30 to the Twyfelfontein Elephant Drives Office, 72km from Lodge Damaraland (60min drive from Lodge Damaraland), in our Lodge Damaraland Air-Conditioned Vehicle, driven by our capable Driver.
- Once we arrive at the Twyfelfontein Elephant Drive Reception, you will have the chance to visit the rest rooms to refresh, where after we will join the expertly guided Elephant Drive in one of their Toyota Land Cruiser pick up trucks, specially adapted for tourism safari drives. This Elephant Drive usually takes about 3 hours.
- After the Elephant Drive, we will depart back to Lodge Damaraland where you can, once more, enjoy our beautiful facilities and restaurant.

GIN AND GEOLOGY SUNDOWNER STROLL

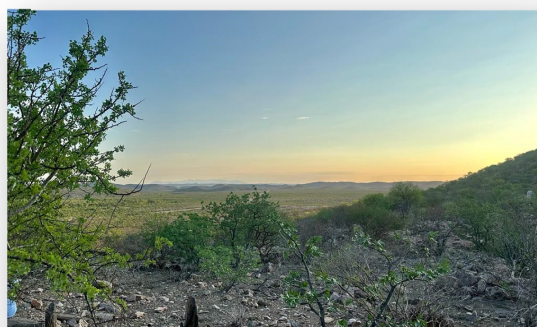
Enjoy the perfect end to your day with an invigorating sundowner walk.

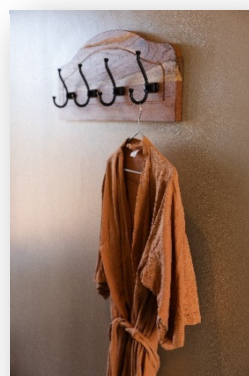
