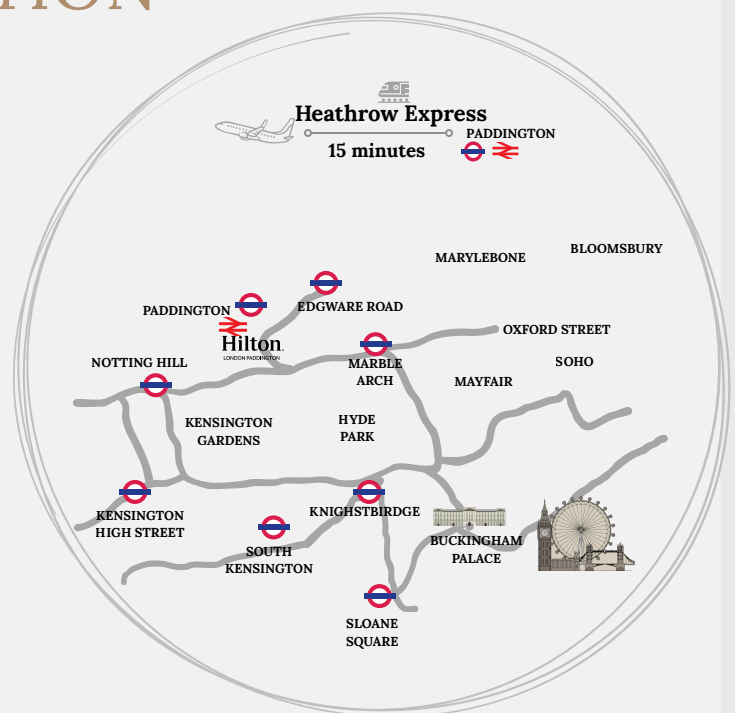
BY TRAIN: Great Western Rail offers fast, direct, connections to Western England & Wales.

BY TUBE: Direct access to Bakerloo, Circle, District, Hammersmith & City, & Elizabeth line.

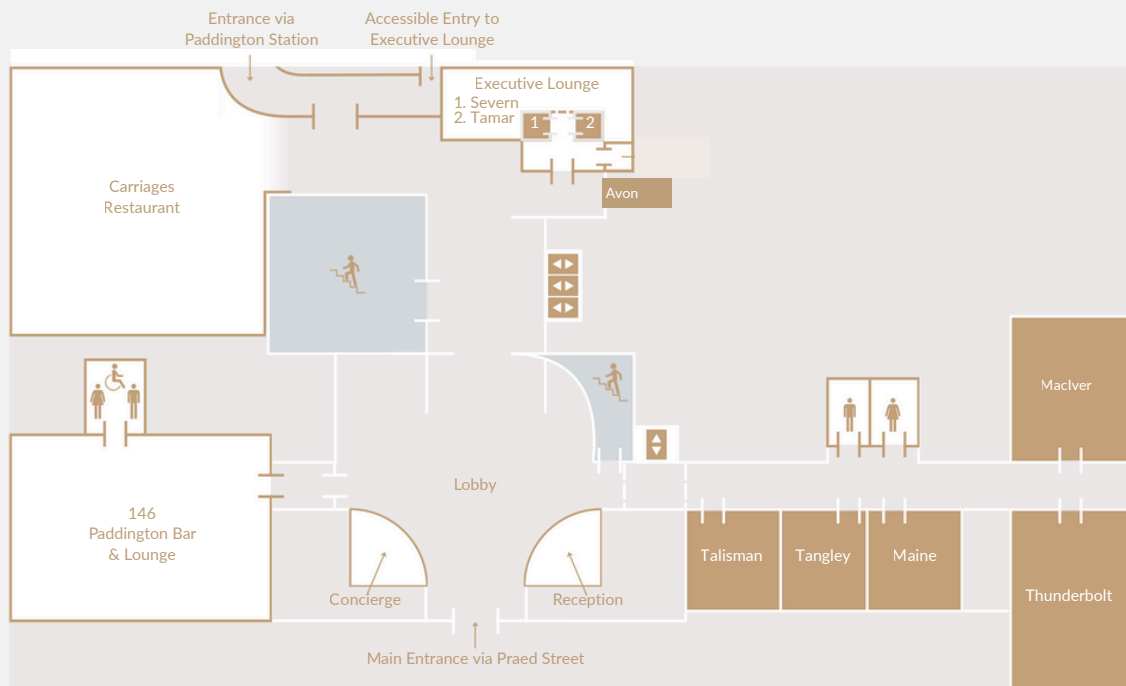
BY PLANE: Direct, 15 minute connection to Heathrow Airport via the Heathrow Express.
