



From Harare - 525 kms (7 hours)

- Travel on the Harare/Beitbridge Road. Pass through Chivhu Town, you may notice a school and an abandoned swimming bath on our left hand side, turn left after these into the Gutu Road (not signposted).
- Travel for 137kms, you will come to a T junction turn left
- Travel for 1.9ms then turn right (this is the Zaka Road)
- Travel for 133kms, you will come to a T junction turn left.
- Travel for 67kms (you will pass the Chiredzi turn off, Chipinda pools turn off) and you will get to the Save River which is spanned by the Jack Quentin Bridge. Cross the bridge.
- Turn immediately right after the bridge (signposted Chilo Gorge) you will now be on a gravel road (on the map ------). Travel for 43 kms on this gravel road, until you get to a further LARGE Chilo Gorge Safari Lodge sign with brick entrance follow the sign to the main reception.
