

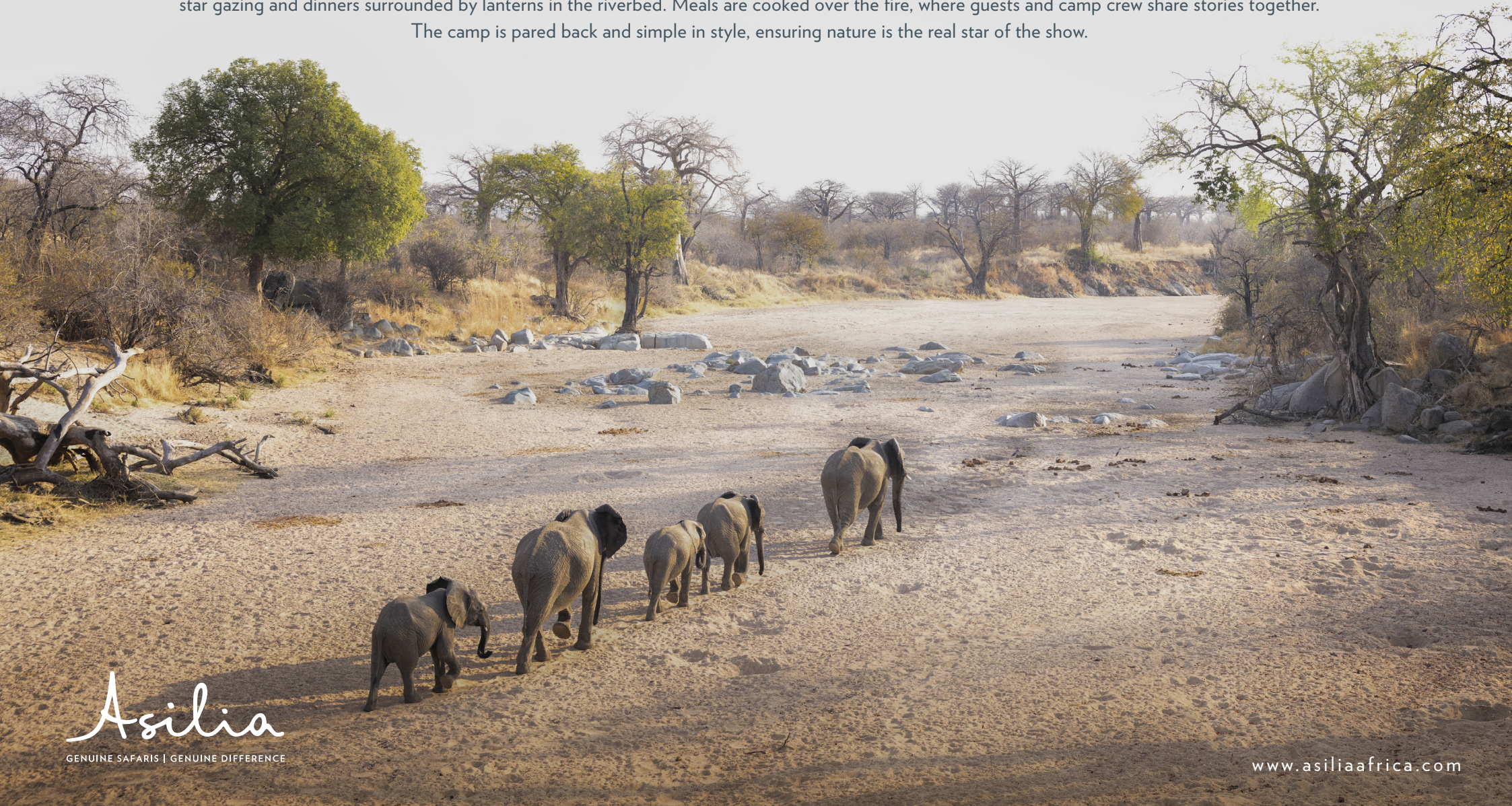


KOKOKO CAMP
