3 NIGHT ITINERARY





An extraordinary voyage around one of the Indian Ocean's most pristine archipelagoes.

NaiSabah is a 75 ft Traditional Omani Dhow that has been carefully repurposed and designed for ocean exploration.

This ultimate expedition style liveaboard offers the perfect platform for group adventures, family safaris, diving expeditions, fishing excursions and conservation journeys.

Based in the warm waters of the Lamu Archipelago, NaiSabah will take you into some of the most pristine and remote marine environments across the region.

3 Night Itinerary Overview

DAY 1

- Arrive at Lamu Airport and meet the dhow
- Join captain Bakari for the orientation, safety briefing and a welcome drink
- Enjoy lunch on the dhow, afternoon swims, dhow activities and a sundowner on the beach
- Dinner will be served on the NaiSabah deck
- Moor and spend the night near Shela Town, sleeping on deck or in the cabins on the lower deck

DAY 2

- Early morning swim down the creek
- Breakfast on the dhow
- Visit either Lamu Old Town, Shela or Takwa heritage sites
- Set sail to Kizingoni beach on the south side of the island
- Afternoon spent on the dhow enjoying activities, sundowners and dinner on deck

DAY 3

- Early morning fishing and snorkelling at Kinyika Island (tide dependent)
- Brunch on the beach or dhow
- Late lunch on board
- Optional watersports in the afternoon at The Cabanas
- Evening spent on the dhow at Kipungani beach

DAY 4

- Early morning activities and breakfast before setting sail back to the northern part of Lamu Island
- 10 am departure from Shela





3 Night Itinerary

- DAY 1** Arrive at Lamu Manda airport where Wimbi, our trusty leisure boat, will provide a transfer to NaiSabah Dhow. After a safety briefing and orientation, enjoy a swim in the tropical waters of the Indian Ocean, before a lunch of fresh seafood on deck. Optional afternoon activities of creek fishing, snorkelling and beach walks. Evening sundowners will be hosted on the Manda beach overlooking the water, before a night at anchorage, sleeping on deck under the stars or in the comfortable cabins.
- DAY 2** Early am rise for optional fishing or creek swimming before breakfast. Visit either Lamu Old Town, Shela or Takwa heritage sites, before setting sail to Kipungani on the South end of Lamu. Relax on board and enjoy the sites and scenes of the Archipelago, alongside an abundance of marine life. Afternoon activities from Kipungani include beach walks, swimming, inshore fishing, water sports, kitesurfing (optional extra) and beach sundowners.
- DAY 3** Enjoy a morning excursion to Kinyika Island (tide dependent) for snorkelling and fishing. Lunch on board followed by an afternoon of beach excursions and optional sundowners on the beach.
- DAY 4** Early morning activities before setting sail back to Shela for your 10 am departure and checkout



Fully equipped for the ultimate coastal adventure with an expert captain and crew, a NaiSabah expedition will leave visitors inspired by the wonderful cultures, and invigorated by the sheer beauty of the East African coastline.

Our vessel boasts three air-conditioned cabins, comfortably accommodating up to eight people. We also offer the unique experience of sleeping under the stars on the open deck.

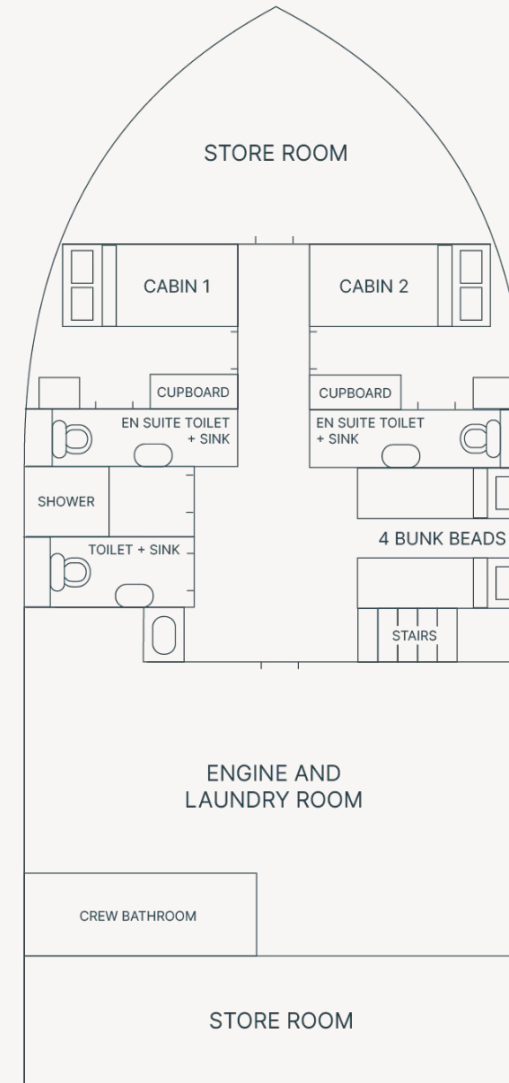
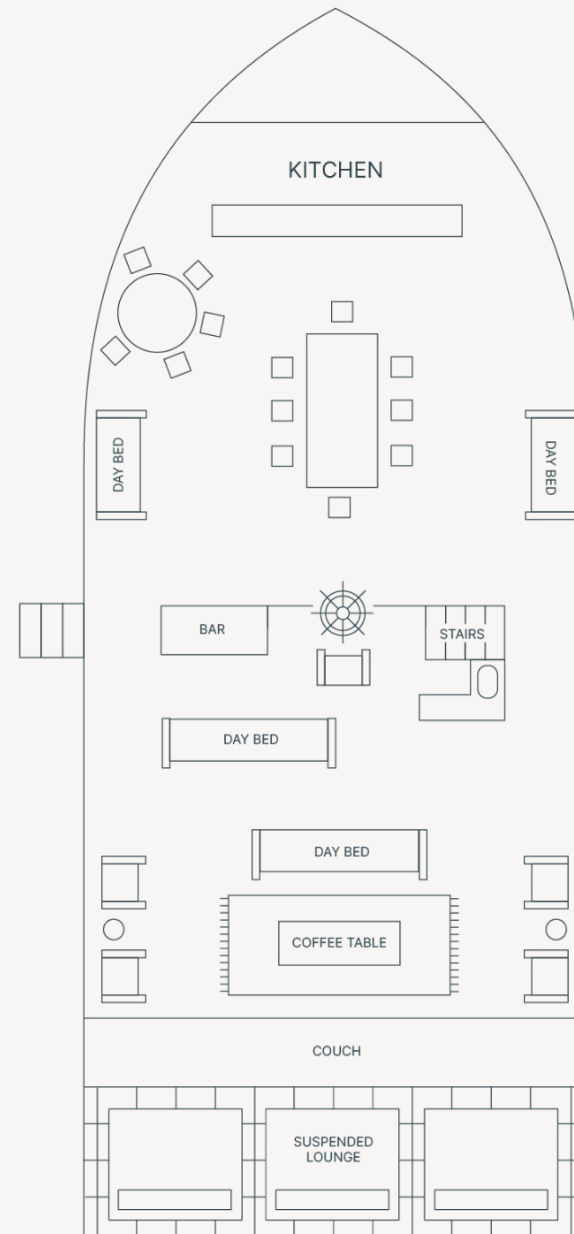

How to get to Lamu

Situated along Kenya's northern coast, Lamu Town boasts its own airport, ensuring convenient accessibility by air. Lamu Airport (LAU) facilitates daily flights from Nairobi Wilson (WIL) operated by three major airlines.

Additionally, we can help organise private charters to fly direct from safari destinations to Lamu.

Upon arrival at the airport, a representative from the NaiSabah team will warmly welcome and escort you to our boat Wimbi, before proceeding to the dhow.
