### The historical Victoria Falls Bridge

Connecting the two towns, Livingstone in Zambia and Victoria Falls in Zimbabwe, the Victoria Falls Bridge was the dream of one man, Cecil John Rhodes, where his vision was for Africa to be connected from Cape-to-Cairo with a continuous railway.

The legend is that he instructed engineers to "build a bridge across the Zambezi where the trains, as they pass, will catch the spray of the Falls". When you consider that this construction began in the turn of the century, in 1903 it really is awe-inspiring!

The Bridge was designed by George Andrew Hobson from consultants Sir Douglas Fox and Partners, who was assisted by Ralph Freeman, a designer of the Sydney Harbour Bridge. The Bridge was built in Great Britain by the Cleveland Bridge & Engineering Company and assembled in Victoria Falls.

Construction only took 14 months and was completed in 1905. Although the building of the bridge was the vision of Cecil John Rhodes, sadly he in fact never visited Victoria Falls and died before construction began in 1902.

However, it is fair to say that his vision was completely realised – not only is The Victoria Falls Bridge the only rail link between Zambia and Zimbabwe – but is a magnificent landmark and one that is sprayed, during the high-water season by the Victoria Falls.

### Livingstone Island Significance

It was in November of 1855 that the Scottish explorer Dr David Livingstone travelled down the Zambezi River to see for himself the spot that the indigenous people called Mosi oa Tunya, or The Smoke that Thunders.

Members of the local Makolo tribe transported Livingstone to the Falls in canoes, so that his first sighting of the largest waterfall in the world was from an island right at the heart of the falling water. Livingstone was so affected by the sight that he exclaimed in his notes, "It has never been seen before by European eyes, but scenes so lovely must have been gazed upon by angels in their flight."

He went on to rename the Falls after his British queen, Victoria, but today the World Heritage List also recognises the original name, Mosi oa Tunya. The island from which Dr Livingstone first witnessed the Falls is the very same island. Now a local heritage site, nothing on the island is permanent except for the David Livingstone Memorial Plaque.


