Surrounded by mopane woodlands and positioned near a well-visited water pan, the camp provides wildlife activity throughout the day. Elephants regularly move through the area, and a variety of predators and plains game traverse the surrounding landscape—making Khanya a rewarding base for keen nature enthusiasts and photographers alike.

Rich in heritage, the land once supported a pioneering cattle operation before being rehabilitated and reintegrated into the Greater Kruger ecosystem. Today, it stands as a living testament to successful restoration and plays a vital role in protecting biodiversity and supporting habitat conservation.

Guests can enjoy guided game drives, tracking sessions, conservation-focused activities, and fireside evenings that echo the spirit of old-world safaris. Khanya blends a raw, grounded bush experience with Bundox's commitment to comfort, care, and responsible tourism.

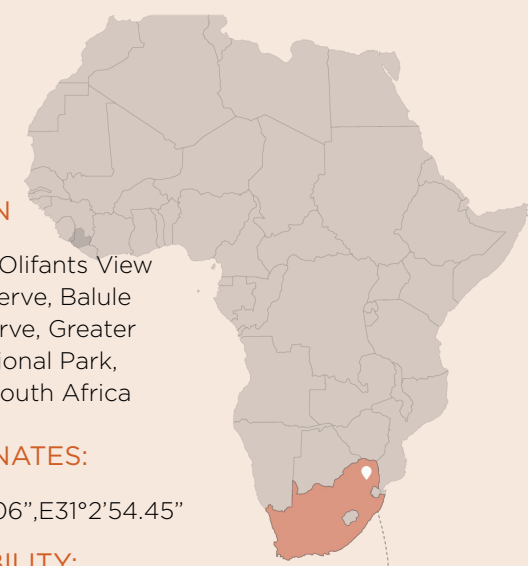
Located in Olifants View Nature Reserve, Balule North Reserve, Greater Kruger National Park, Limpopo, South Africa
