📍 BWINDI IMPENETRABLE FOREST

Access to Bwindi Impenetrable Forest in Uganda is easy to incorporate as part of a wider trip within East Africa, or a Uganda-only itinerary. Here we outline the best ways to get to Erebero Hills.

BY AIR

You can fly by light aircraft daily from Entebbe to Kihiki Airstrip, a journey of approximately one and a half hours, with a stop at Kisoro to drop off/pick up passengers on the way.

From here, a guide from Erebero Hills will meet you and drive you through the rolling hills and towards the northern area of Bwindi Impenetrable Forest. The drive will take approximately one hour and a half.

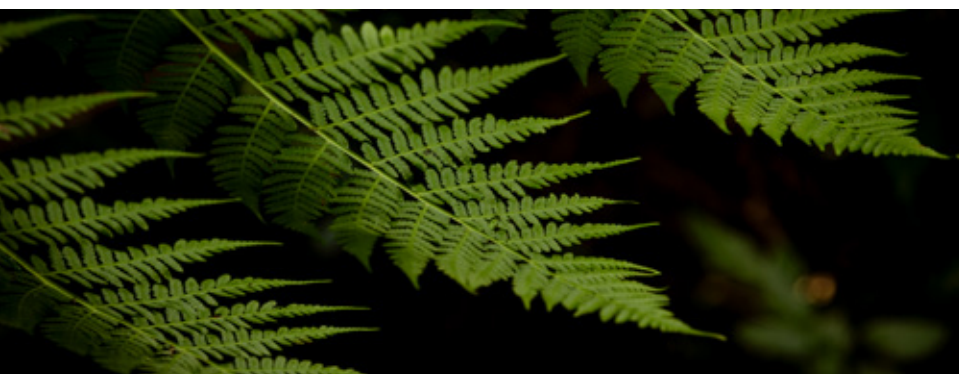
The current flight schedule is below, subject to change by the airlines:

CONNECTING TO THE MASAI MARA

Fly from the Masai Mara to Nairobi, where you'll connect under your own arrangements to Entebbe. Overnight in Entebbe and connect by air to Kihiki the next day as outlined in the table above. Alternatively, guests can book a private charter between the Masai Mara and Entebbe. Your Asilia consultant can advise on options and cost.



CONNECTING TO THE SERENGETI

Auric Air offers a great connection between the Serengeti and Entebbe. The flight operates on Saturday, Sunday, Tuesday and Thursday.

The connections work as outlined below, with a stop in Mwanza to complete immigration formalities. However, depending on the routing on that day, there is a possibility the immigration stop will be made in Musoma or Bukoba, rather than Mwanza. Regardless of the routing, Mwanza International Airport can be used as the entry point for visa purposes. The timings and routings are subject to change by the airline. We recommend all travellers have secured visas in advance of travel to ensure an efficient border process.

From Entebbe, travellers can fly to Kihiki with Aerolink Uganda as described above.

Minimum 4 passengers required per sector to operate.

Alternatively, you can enquire about a private charter from Serengeti to Kihikihi (via Mwanza and Entebbe).

BY ROAD

A driving safari is another great option for visiting Bwindi Impenetrable Forest, allowing you to explore more of Uganda's landscapes, national parks, and wildlife. We can organise a driver-guide and 4x4 vehicle, much as you would experience on a driving safari through Northern Tanzania for example, who will be with you throughout your safari, from your initial arrival at Entebbe and beyond.

From Entebbe the drive to Bwindi is too far to recommend doing in one day, so most travellers break the journey at Lake Mburo National Park which is around 5 hours drive, passing through the bustling city of Kampala, through rural farmland, rice paddies, and small villages. After one or two nights here, you can travel onwards to Bwindi, which is another approximately 5 hours drive. The terrain becomes more hilly and dramatic as you journey southwest towards Bwindi, with terraced fields covering the hills in a patchwork quilt.

After your stay in Bwindi you can continue onward by road to other national parks such as Queen Elizabeth, Murchison Falls, and Kibale Forest, or opt to fly back to Entebbe.
