From TAASA Lodge, guests can enjoy day trips to the Mara River throughout the year, offering opportunities to witness Mara River crossings in quieter, more pristine surroundings.

- Open-sided safari vehicles for unobstructed views.
- Off-road capability and nighttime game drives in the Poleleti Game Reserve (private land), allowing respectful, flexible wildlife viewing beyond fixed tracks.
- Exclusive viewing of resident and migratory wildlife - away from the congestion often seen in public parks.
