

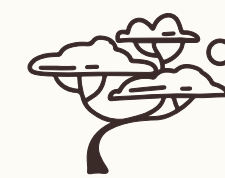

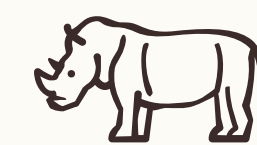
Holding the line for the Greater Serengeti

FCF manages 230,000 hectares of wilderness along the Serengeti's edge — keeping the Great Migration's ancient routes open and the rule of law firmly in place. In 2025, anti-poaching units were restructured, patrols expanded, and 30+ black rhinos tagged in a landmark darting initiative across the greater Serengeti and Ngorongoro ecosystem.

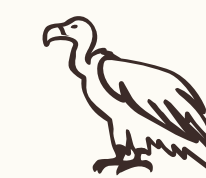
Over 13,200 hectares of invasive acacia were cleared and three new dams built — bringing wildlife back to restored land.

Real lives, real impact

Nearly 2,500 children receive a hot meal every school day — and at Makao Primary, absenteeism has fallen from 30% to just 2% since 2022. Scholarships support 57 students, up from 17 in 2023. All 7 interns from FCF's first hospitality programme secured jobs at Legendary Expeditions.

On the economic side, community beekeeping has grown from 500 kg in its first year to 2,200 kg this season — with 80% of groups led by women. A new three-year empowerment project launched in April 2025 aims to create 2,475 jobs and support 2,700 individuals.
