## M A N A   S A N D S M A I N   C A M P

## GETTING HERE

Access to Mana Sands is an adventure in itself, ensuring the remoteness and exclusivity of your safari:

**BY AIR** | The most convenient way to reach us is via a light aircraft flight from Harare or Victoria Falls to Mana West Airstrip (approximately 1.5 hours from Harare). From there, it's a scenic 5-minute game drive to camp.

The second runway option is Mana Pools Airstrip which is about a two hour scenic drive from camp.

**BY ROAD** | For those seeking a self-drive adventure, Mana Sands can be reached from Harare (approx. 7.5-8.5 hours) or Lusaka (approx. 5-6 hours). A 4x4 vehicle is essential for the final stretch through the park in the rainy season.

**BY BOAT** | Private boat transfers along the Zambezi River can also be arranged from Chirundu, offering a spectacular waterborne approach with game viewing along the way.

Whether arriving by air, road, or river, every journey to Mana Sands is part of the safari experience, bringing you closer to the untamed beauty of Mana Pools.
