THE RHYTHM OF YOUR DAY

MORNING GAME DRIVE

As dawn breaks, the savannah slowly awakens. Guided by our rangers, you set out in an open 4x4 to witness the bush at its most alive. Antelope graze in the early light, giraffes move gracefully across the horizon, and the first calls of birdlife break the silence. Binoculars are available for an even closer look.

BREAKFAST

After the adventure, return to the lodge where breakfast is served with sweeping views of the plains. Fresh fruit and pastries, the chef's daily special, barista coffees, and loose-leaf teas await you.

LUNCH

Midday at Maloba is unhurried and refined. Lunch is served on the lodge's deck, where endless views stretch across the savannah. Expect seasonal, farm-to-table dishes paired with fine South African wines.

AFTERNOON GAME DRIVE

As the afternoon begins to cool, your game drive sets out across the reserve. Along the way, you'll pause to watch giraffes moving through the thorn trees, herds of antelope grazing in the golden light, and flocks of birds returning to roost. Binoculars are available for an even closer look. As night falls, the drive continues back to the lodge under a starlit sky, a chance to glimpse the nocturnal life of the bush as it awakens after dark.

DINNER

Evenings at Maloba are a celebration of fine dining. In the lodge's elegant setting, each course is crafted with seasonal, locally sourced ingredients and paired with South Africa's most distinguished vintages. Soft candlelight, refined flavours, and attentive service create an atmosphere of quiet sophistication, the perfect end to an extraordinary day in the wild.

DIAMOND MINE EXPERIENCE - R56500

RHINO & CAPE BUFFALO DARTING - R256300

Per experience Duration: 5 hours

Up to 10 guests join our rangers, veterinarians and helicopter crew in the safe darting of rhino and buffalo for essential monitoring, including GPS tracking and ear-tag removal. Offered only a few times a year, this rare, behind-the-scenes experience supports Maloba's vital conservation work and the protection of Africa's endangered wildlife.

January	34	17	Light rain jacket, breathable shirts, sandals, and insect repellent.
February	33	17	Long sleeves for evening bugs, closed shoes for muddy terrain.
March	31	15	Neutral-colored layers, hat with chin strap, quick-dry socks.
April	27	10	Warm fleece for mornings, shorts for daytime, camera rain cover.
May	24	5	Gloves & beanie for sunrise drives, warm jacket, sunblock.
June	21	2	Thermal base layer, windbreaker, scarf. Layers are your best friend.
July	20	1	Thick fleece, warm boots, extra socks, lip balm.
August	23	4	Sunglasses, buff or light scarf for dust, cozy evening wear.
