What's Included

- Accommodation in spacious Sahara A-frame tents, furnished with beds, mattresses, fitted sheets, duvets, bedside tables, solar lights, and mats for added comfort
- Linen bag with essentials provided
- Wild camp set-up at each overnight stop, including tents, dining area, kitchen, and fire circle prepared by the back-up team
- Hot bush showers, eco-friendly toilets, and a hand-wash station at each camp
- Drinking water is supplied throughout the safari
- All meals, with dietary requirements catered for (please list these on your booking form)
- Early morning tea, coffee, and rusks
- Mid-morning brunch with juice, fruit, coffee, and tea
- Afternoon snack
- Fireside dinner under the stars
- Luggage transfers – hikers carry only a light daypack, while your bags are transported between camps
- Experienced guides leading the trail, sharing local knowledge of the land, wildlife, and culture



What's Not Included

- **Flights**

Guests are responsible for booking their own international and domestic flights to and from Namibia. Please let us know if you need guidance on recommended routes or timings.

- **Transfers**

Transfers to and from the starting/ending points of the hike are not automatically included. However, we are happy to assist in arranging private or shared transfers on request. Simply let us know your travel plans in advance so we can quote accordingly.

- **Tour Planning**

If you would like to combine your hiking safari with other destinations in Namibia, our team can assist with planning and bookings. From self-drive routes to guided safaris, we will gladly help you design a complete itinerary that suits your travel style.

- **Alcoholic Beverages**

While all drinking water, tea, and coffee are included, alcoholic and soft drinks are not. We do provide a basic camp bar stocked with a selection of beers, ciders, soft drinks, wine, gin, and whiskey. This operates on an honesty system and accounts can be settled in cash at the end of the trip. If you would like any special drinks, please let us know in advance.



A Day on a WWS Hike: What to Expect

5:30 AM – Wake up to the aroma of freshly brewed tea and coffee, accompanied by traditional rusks. A peaceful start to the day as the wilderness awakens around you.

6:15 AM – Set off on the hike just as the sun rises, painting the sky with breathtaking colours.

10:00 AM – Brunch stop (timing depends on the group's pace). Enjoy a well-earned, delicious meal, replenish your drinking water from the backup vehicle, and take a moment to soak in the beauty of your surroundings.

11:00 AM – Resume the hike, continuing through diverse landscapes and wildlife-rich terrain.

2:00 PM – Arrive back at camp. Kick off your boots and sink your feet into a refreshing foot spa with a cold drink in hand. The afternoon is yours—shower, nap, or simply unwind in the tranquillity of the wild.

6:30 PM – Gather under the vast, starlit sky for a hearty dinner, expertly prepared and served in the heart of nature.

Additional Notes

If you ever need a break from hiking, you're welcome to ride with the backup crew for a section.

Backup vehicles are equipped with USB charging points, but we recommend bringing a power bank and solar charger for convenience.
