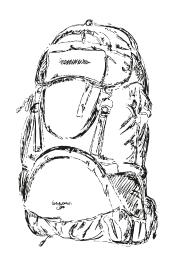


Packing list



Preparing for Your Stay at Tierra Atacama

Atacama's dry and temperate weather calls for layered clothing. Start with a moisture-wicking first layer to keep you dry, and add a fleece jacket for warmth. While trekking shorts are suitable, we recommend pants to protect your legs. A hat, sunscreen, and a buff are essential for sun and wind protection. Gloves are necessary for high-altitude treks.

Layered Clothing

- First Layer: Moisture-wicking base layers to keep you dry.
- Middle Layer: A warm sweater or fleece jacket for insulation.
- Outer Layer: A warm windbreaker and an optional waterproof jacket for protection against wind and rain.
- Trekking Shorts and Pants: Shorts are suitable for all excursions, but we recommend wearing pants to protect your legs from scratches and vegetation.
- Hiking Boots: Waterproof and sturdy boots are essential for all excursions.
- Gloves and Hat: Gloves are necessary for higher altitude treks and volcano ascents. A hat to protect you from the sun.
- Buff/Scarf: Useful for protection against wind, cold, and sand.
- Trekking Socks: Comfortable and moisture-wicking socks for long hikes.
- Underclothing: Proper underclothing that supports active movements.
- Swimwear: Don't forget a bathing suit to enjoy our Uma Spa.

Accessories

- Sunscreen and Lip Protection: High SPF sunscreen and lip balm to protect your skin from the intense sun.
- Sunglasses: A good pair of sunglasses to shield your eyes from the bright desert sun.
- Backpack/Daypack: For carrying essentials during excursions.
- Binoculars and Camera: Capture the breathtaking landscapes and wildlife.
- Trekking poles/sticks: We provide trekking poles/sticks for guests to borrow at the hotel.
