





Surrender to your senses in a secluded experience lodge on a private peninsula on the shores of Lake Titicaca, with an enigmatic sense of peaceful solitude at nearly 4000 meters above sea level. Go beyond the ethereal landscapes, traditional communities and ancient ways of the region while you discover the intriguing allure of Lake Titicaca where sky, earth, and water connect.





LOCATION

Surrounded by stunning scenery, Titilaka is located on a tranquil private peninsula facing the Taquile and Uros islands to the north; the Bolivian Cordillera Real to the East and Lake Titicaca stretching from East to West. An

unspoiled corner of the world at nearly 4000 metres above sea level that is renowned for its magical beauty and home to traditional Aymara and Quechua communities.

THE LODGE

Titilaka's architectural concept is closely linked to its special location, starkly positioned between water, mountains and sky. Designed to integrate with the environment, the lodge pays homage to the local communities via artesanal textiles and decorations. The three-storey lodge offers 18 lake-view rooms, 3 lounges, outdoor wrap-around terraces, an overwater deck, and a fully-stocked bar with a large regional wine cellar. At the tip of the peninsula lies the dock, departure point for all island excursions. A bit further you'll find our boat house, the first nautical sports facility on Lake Titicaca.

ROOMS

The hotel features 18 rooms, each with an exceptional view of the lake. Divided on three floors, each room is fitted with heated floors and contemporary furniture complemented by local textiles. The spacious bathrooms include a private shower, separate washbasin, toilet and an oversized tub (except for Explorer).




Explorer: Our 4 Explorer rooms (28 m²/ 301 sq. ft.) on the ground and first floor, form an intimate and cosy retreat with an unforgettable lake view.

Dawn: Dawn's striking scenery at sunrise allows you to fully appreciate the lake's breathtaking allure. Located on the first and second floor, the 8 rooms range between 30-40 m² (322-430 sq. ft.).

Dusk: With sunsets that showcase both the Lake and its neighbouring reeds, the 4 Dusk Rooms range between 29 and 47 m^2 (308-505 sq. ft.)

Corner: Corner boasts spectacular sunset and sunrise sights of the lake from all its angles. The 2 rooms vary between 38 and 43 m² (409-463 sq. ft.).





We will take care of every detail so you can spend all of your time experiencing the lake and its surroundings.

During your stay, all meals and selected drinks are fully included. Enjoy a diverse à-la-carte menu as well as a daily afternoon tea and sundowner and an in-room minibar. We will make sure you are fully taken care of at all times via our 24/7 room service, complimentary Wi-Fi and international

phone calls, as well as our on-site nurse and oxygen should you need a bit of help to adapt to the altitude. Spa treatments, premium drinks, cribs and nannies, VIP airport lounge access and laundry services are available upon request for an additional cost.

Titilaka's contemporary menu offers a unique take on Peruvian cuisine with a special emphasis on local Andean ingredients. Executive Chef, María Fé Garcia, was inspired by the ethereal beauty of the Lake and created a nutritious and filling menu that is also light enough for guests to easily adapt to the altitude.

EXCURSIONS

Staying at Titilaka means you can discover the lake by joining the adventurous excursions led by our bilingual expert guides. You can choose between 14 excursions in Peru and 2 into Bolivia (additional cost) to explore the region's distinctive gastronomy, nature, history and culture.

Explore a floating Uros island, visit traditional weaving artists, go kayaking at sunrise, or spot Aymara constellations after sunset. As a part of our sustainability pledge, many excursions were set up in collaboration with the local communities, creating an authentic experience for our guests while providing the communities with a stable income.

Excursions are arranged on a shared-basis, with the option to upgrade and privatize transfers and guiding.
