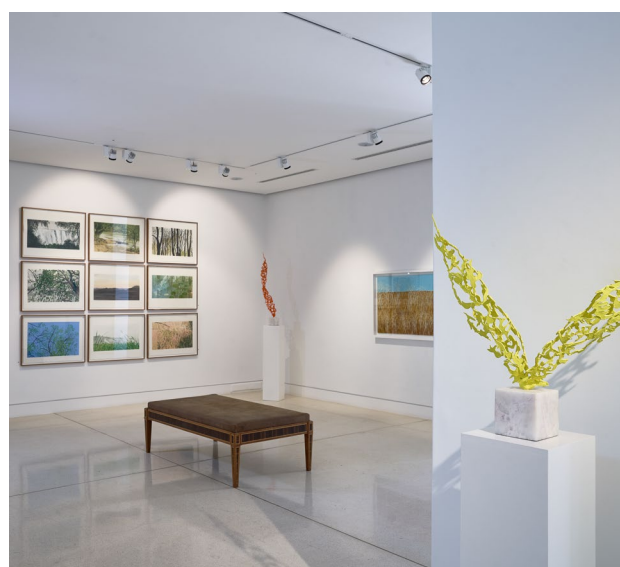
EVERARD READ GALLERIES

At Leeu Estates & Le Quartier Français

There are two [Everard Read galleries in Franschhoek](#): one adjacent to Le Quartier Français and the other at Leeu Estates on the flagship property of Leeu Collection. These galleries showcase contemporary art year-round through solo and group exhibitions.

Everard Read at Leeu Estates, opened in November 2020, combines a gallery and sculpture park, emphasising monumental sculptures set amid stunning fynbos and vineyards, and showcasing significant works in its purpose-built gallery.

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ART GALLERIES

Franschhoek

[AITY Gallery](#), founded in 2012, is a contemporary art gallery in the heart of the Franschhoek Valley. Showcasing a diverse range of art forms and unique handcrafted items while promoting experimentation and innovation within the art world. The [Pigcasso Art Gallery](#) at Farm Sanctuary SA, founded in 2016, introduced visitors to its extraordinary resident, 'Pigcasso,' the renowned painting pig. In collaboration with Joanne Lefson, she created remarkable artworks that highlight the connections among food systems, animals, and climate change. Her legacy continues to inspire. [EBONY/CURATED](#), a leading South African gallery spanning three locations, two of which are in Franschhoek, highlights contemporary and notable modern artworks.

SCULPTURE GARDEN TOURS

Stellenbosch

Explore the lush and inspiring gardens of the Cape Winelands. A short 16 kilometres from Franschhoek, [Boschendal](#) offers guided walking tours that provide insights into the farm's history, regenerative farming practices, and sustainable gardening. These tours also offer opportunities for harvesting herbs and fruit, allowing you to immerse yourself in the beauty of the Cape Winelands. Just 21 kilometres from Franschhoek, [Babylonstoren's](#) garden, inspired by Cape Town's historic Company's Gardengarden, inspired by Cape Town's historic Company's Garden, is central to the farm's heritage and provides fresh produce. Located 37 kilometres from Franschhoek, The [Dylan Lewis Sculpture Garden](#) on Stellenbosch Mountain spans seven hectares, offering expansive vistas, serene groves, and sculptures that express the untamed wilderness within the human psyche.
