CAPE TOWN

Cape Town is a city where mountains meet the sea, and every view feels like it belongs on a postcard. At the heart of it all is Table Mountain, rising dramatically above the city with hiking trails, cable car rides, and sweeping views that stretch from the Atlantic to False Bay. Down below, the city pulses with life, from the colourful Bo-Kaap neighbourhood to bustling markets, world-class restaurants, and a thriving arts scene.

Beyond the city itself, Cape Town is the gateway to some of the most stunning natural wonders in South Africa. The Cape Peninsula offers winding coastal drives, penguin colonies at Boulders Beach, and the wild beauty of Cape Point. Just a short trip inland, the Cape Winelands invite you to sip award-winning wines among rolling vineyards and historic estates.

What makes Cape Town truly special, though, is its blend of cultures, history, and nature. It's a place where you can surf in the morning, hike in the afternoon, and end the day with a glass of wine while watching the sun dip into the Atlantic. Whether you're drawn to adventure, relaxation, or discovery, Cape Town has it all.



CAPE Collection


Cape Town's icons begin with Table Mountain, where you can hike or glide up by cable car to enjoy sweeping views of the city, ocean, and peninsula. Nearby, Lion's Head offers a moderately challenging hike and is especially popular at sunrise and sunset.

A short boat ride away is Robben Island, the place where Nelson Mandela was imprisoned, offering a moving journey into South Africa's past. In the city itself, the Bo-Kaap draws visitors with its colourful houses, Cape Malay culture, and heritage stories, while the V&A Waterfront is a lively hub of shopping, dining, boat trips, and contemporary African art at Zeitz MOCAA.

Nature lovers are spoiled for choice: Cape Point and the Cape of Good Hope boast dramatic cliffs, lighthouses, and wildlife at the tip of the peninsula, while the winding Chapman's Peak Drive is among the world's most scenic coastal roads. Kirstenbosch Botanical Garden, with its lush landscapes, trails, and canopy walkway, sits at the foot of the mountains.

Beyond the city, the Cape Winelands—Constantia, Stellenbosch, and Franschhoek—offer world-class wine estates and leisurely lunches. And in Simon's Town, Boulders Beach provides a rare chance to stroll or swim alongside a colony of African penguins.





WELGELEGEN *House*

At the foot of the majestic Table Mountain, Welgelegen House captures the timeless allure of Cape Town. Once two Victorian family homes and even served as an orphanage for Jewish children, this sanctuary has been reimagined as a welcoming “home away from home.” Today, it features 14 superbly appointed en-suite rooms, connected by a tranquil, leafy courtyard that invites relaxation away from the city’s hustle and bustle.

A refreshing plunge pool offers respite on warm days, while the friendly team is on hand to share local insights, from the best spots on Kloof Street to the breathtaking views from Table Mountain’s Cableway. Welgelegen House is ideally located, with Camps Bay and the V&A Waterfront just a short drive away, making it the perfect base for exploring all that Cape Town has to offer.





SUPERIOR *Rooms*

Enjoy a little more space in our Superior rooms. Each of the 9 Superior rooms is appointed with extra-length king size beds (convertible into twins), air conditioning, en-suite bathroom (with either a shower or a shower and a bath), satellite television, a safe, mini-bar, telephone, hairdryer, coffee and tea station and complimentary Wi-Fi access.

SUPERIOR FAMILY *Rooms*

Each of the 2 superior family rooms in Welgelegen House has extra-length king size beds (convertible into twins), air conditioning, en-suite bathroom, satellite television, a safe, mini-bar, telephone, hairdryer and complimentary Wi-Fi access. One of the rooms has an inter-leading room with two single beds that can accommodate a family of 4. The other Superior Family room has an inter-leading room with one single bed that can accommodate a family of 3.


