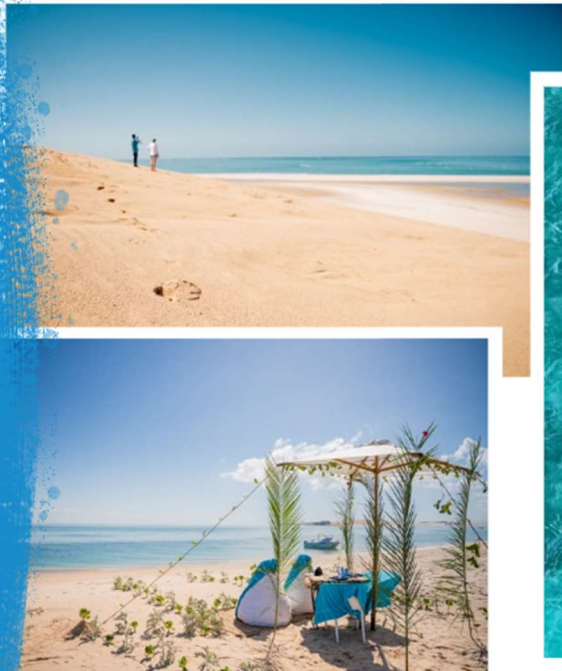

No shoes are needed.

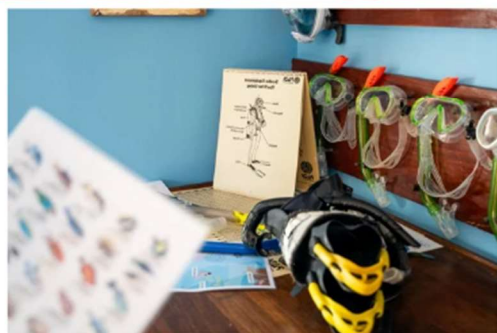


## Snorkeling @ Two Mile Reef

### PADI – THE WAY THE WORLD LEARNS TO DIVE!

Azura is a PADI 5-star Dive Centre with excellent instructors and top of the range ScubaPro equipment. We have a training pool perfect for refreshing your diving skills or taking a course. Azura is also a Diver's Alert Network Industry Partner which entitles all divers to do entry level courses a basic dive insurance coverage.

#### COURSES:

##### SCUBA REVIEW - USD 110 PER PERSON

PADI recommends that you take part in a review of your skills if you haven't been diving for at least 6 months. This course will review your theory and refresh your skills in the pool. This takes approximately one hour.

##### BUBBLEMAKER - USD 100 PER PERSON

The Bubblemaker experience is as fun as it sounds - a chance for kids to blow bubbles whilst scuba diving. Kids from the age of 8 can get the thrill of using scuba gear to breathe underwater and swim around in the safe and shallow environment of our training pool. It is a great way to introduce kids to scuba diving. After a short brief kids then hop in the pool where they learn basic key skills. After that, the rest of the time is just having fun blowing bubbles.

##### DISCOVER SCUBA DIVING - USD 225 PER PERSON

A perfect introduction to the underwater world. You will learn some basic theory then be taught 5 key underwater skills in the training pool. Afterwards head out on the boat and go for your first dive. You will receive a certificate that counts towards your full Open Water course should you decide to move forward with your training within the next 6 months. The pool session takes approximately one hour and the open water dive in the ocean is a 2 hour round trip. Available for everyone ages 10 and above.



### OPEN WATER SCUBA DIVER - USD 700 PER PERSON

Once you learn how to dive your view of our beautiful planet completely changes. The underwater world is fascinating and inspiring. Completion of the PADI Open Water course allows you to dive to a depth of 18 meters, without supervision. The course consists of 5 theory sections, 5 pool sections, a final exam and 4 open water dives. It Includes all diving equipment and documents for your certification. Kindly note that learning materials are not included and needs to be purchased on the PADI website. The course takes approximately 30 hours split over a 4–5-day period. Ages 10 and above.

### SCUBA DIVER - USD 385 PER PERSON

If you have limited time this course is the perfect choice for you. It is essentially just over half of the Open Water course mentioned above. It certifies you to a depth of 12 meters, and all subsequent dives must be under the direct supervision of a Divemaster or Instructor. The course consists of 3 theory sections, 3 pool sections and 2 open water dives. It all counts towards your full PADI Open Water Diver qualification, which you can take at a later stage. The course Includes all diving equipment and documents for your certification. Kindly note that learning materials are not included and needs to be purchased on the PADI website. The course takes approximately 15 hours over a 2-day period. Ages 10 and above.

### SCUBA DIVER TO OPEN WATER DIVER - USD 300 PER PERSON

This course is the steppingstone to your full Open Water certification for those already qualified as a PADI Scuba Diver. It begins by reviewing your existing skills and knowledge and is then followed by 2 additional theory and pool sessions, the final exam and the remaining 2 open water dives which are required for your new rating. You will need to have with you your logbook as well as your referral form/student record signed by your previous PADI instructor. The course takes approximately 15 hours over a 2-day period. Ages 10 and up and only available for current PADI Scuba Divers.

### OPEN WATER REFERRAL - USD 575 PER PERSON

This is the completion stage of your Open Water course. You will have already completed your theory, final exam and possibly your confined water training as well. Our PADI instructors will talk with you and guide you through whatever remains for you to do. If you are doing a referral, please note you are required to have with you your referral form/student record signed by your previous PADI instructor.

### ADVANCED OPEN WATER DIVER - USD 600 PER PERSON

If you want to take your diving skills to the next level, consider the Advanced Open Water Diver course. There are 5 knowledge reviews to complete which correspond to 5 qualifying dives. There are 2 mandatory dives: Deep and Navigation. The remaining 3 you choose yourself: Peak Performance Buoyancy, Fish ID, Boat, Drift and Underwater Naturalist to name but a few. Any of these will enhance your diving abilities and skills and will make diving even more fun than it already is. The course takes approximately 15 hours over a 3-day period.

Chat with our dive professional to see what other options are available. We also offer the Adventure Diver course, or you can do a single Adventure dive. Please note course duration times listed are approximate and are subject to weather conditions and student competency.

Trawling with our local guides gives you a great day out on the water. Kindly note that we do not offer Fly Fishing, but this can be arranged with an outsourced company.

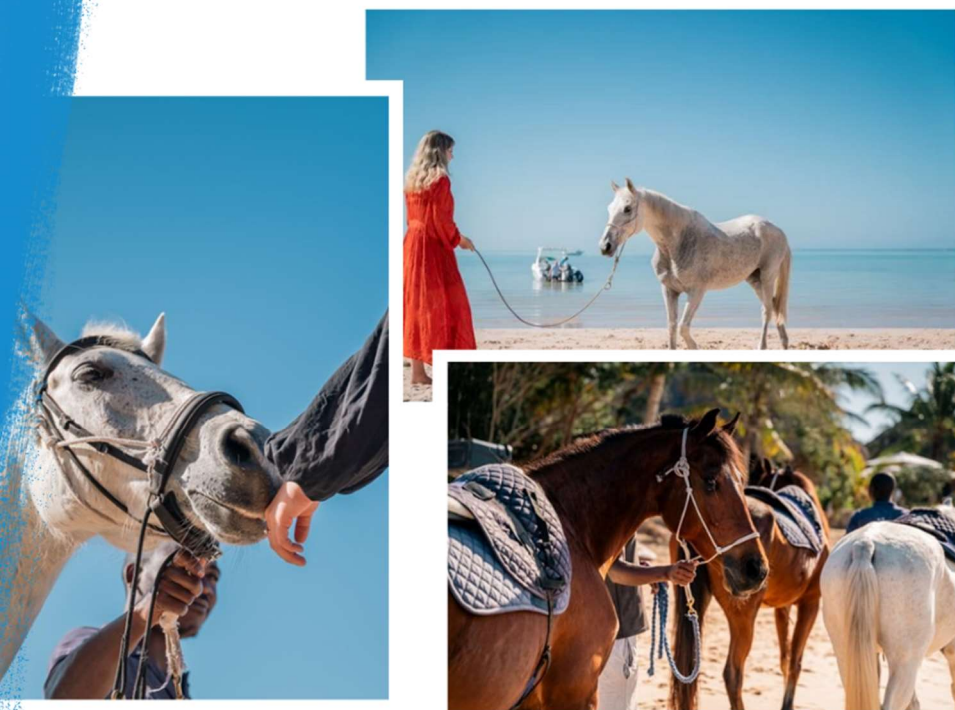
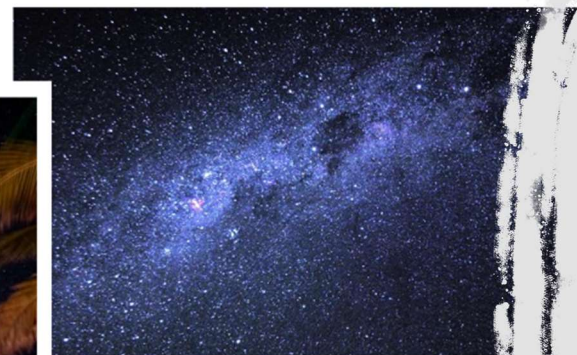


# Immersed in NATURE

## Stargazing

### COMPLIMENTARY

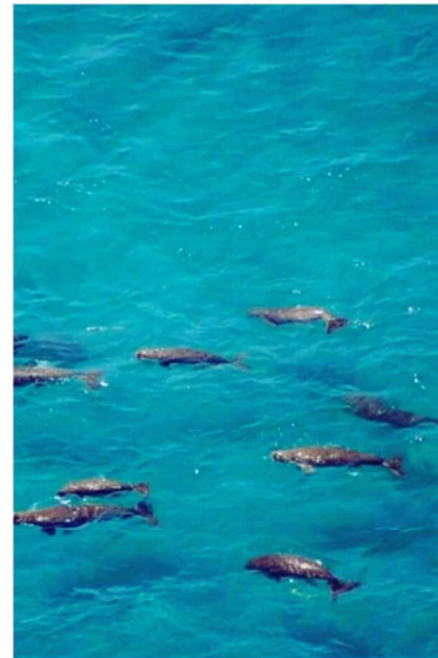
Experience the rare privilege of observing these majestic giants going about their natural behaviour. Every year, Humpback Whales make a long and arduous annual migration from the cold waters of the Antarctic to the warm waters of the Equator to give birth. Passing through our channels between July and October, providing incredible sightings as they frolic in the warm waters around the island.

## Dugong Spotting

Visit the last remaining population of these majestic marine mammals in the West Indian Ocean, where they frolic year-round in the aquamarine waters.

Called the “mermaids of the sea” Dugongs gather on the reefs where they gently graze on sea grass, making it possible for you drift close and marvel at these peaceful and awe-inspiring creatures.





## Island Drive

**1ST TRIP COMPLIMENTARY, USD 25 PER PERSON THEREAFTER**

Delve into life on Bengueria Island as you visit local communities and explore the wild side. The drive takes you through beautiful island landscapes to the happy homes of our local islanders. Visit the school built by Azura's Rainbow Fund in 2008, where 490 children now have the opportunity of primary education and 34 children on the mainland attend High School. Then, take a turn past the first-ever clinic on the island, offering health screening and medications previously unavailable, also built by our Rainbow Fund. Learn about indigenous fauna and flora as you take in the breath-taking panoramic views of Bengueria Island. This 2-hour activity is available twice a day, departing from reception at either 9:00am or 3:00pm. It is guided by a local island staff member with an array of knowledge that he will share with you, refreshments are available on board the vehicle.



## Island Football "Soccer"

**COMPLIMENTARY**

The whole of Africa is football (soccer) mad, and here on Bengueria Island it's no different. There is an Island League made up of teams from the different lodges and villages. It is an important event amongst the local community with lots of pride at stake. Come and support the Azura team at one of their matches over the weekend. We will set up shade and refreshments, and if you're up for it you can even join in the game. It's great fun for everyone. Duration approximately 2 hours on a Sunday afternoon.





## Marine Walk

### COMPLIMENTARY

Our marine walk is amongst the magnificent activities that you can enjoy at Azura. The coastal environment provides important breeding areas and nursery grounds for a wide variety of creatures including fish, small shrimps and even seahorses. Additionally, seagrass habitats like the one we have in front of Azura serve as foraging arenas for flamingos and magnificent marine birds. Join our inhouse marine biologist for a short walk alongside the beach to learn about the astonishing biodiversity of Benguerra Island and the importance of protecting and conserving our ocean. This activity takes approximately 30 minutes and is tide dependent.
