

# Directions to Okonjima Nature Reserve



OKONJIMA IS HALF-WAY  
BETWEEN WINDHOEK AND  
ETOSHA NATIONAL PARK  
(2½ HOURS DRIVE FROM  
WINDHOEK / 10KM OFF THE  
B1)



To those coming from the south (B1): Take the gravel turn-off to your left, just after the sign "Otjiwarongo 50 km".

To those coming from the north (B1): Take the gravel turn-off to the right, just after the sign "Okahandja 130 km". This turn-off is approximately 48 km south of Otjiwarongo and 10 km off the B1 – the main road running north-south.

There is an excellent tar road from Windhoek (B1) – 2½ hours' drive from Windhoek, 3 hours' drive from Hosea Kutako International Airport, and 3–4 hours' drive to Etosha. There are 10 km of gravel road once you turn off the B1 to our Nature Reserve entrance gate, and another 14–16 km of gravel road to our camps. Please call ahead to confirm road conditions during the summer months.

**Air access:** Private airstrip – 1.3 km away, a 5-minute drive from Main Camp, 15 minutes from Bush Camp, 20 minutes from Bush Suite, and 25–30 minutes from The Villa.

**Coordinates:** S 20° 51' 59" E 16° 38' 22"

**Property size:** 22,000 ha / 55,000 acres / 220 km<sup>2</sup> – Okonjima Lodge encompasses four farms: Okonjima (6,000 ha), Ombujongwe (7,500 ha), Joumbira (4,000 ha), and Marathon (4,500 ha).

**Parking:** All four camps offer under-roof parking for private vehicles. The Campsite has no allocated parking spaces.

Okonjima is bordered by rivers that remain dry for most of the year. However, guests are advised to check on accessibility during the rainy season.
