With carefully curated menus, produce imported from approved suppliers, a team of expertly trained staff, and the option of bringing in a private Mashgiach to supervise all meals for the duration of their stay, guests can make the most of their holiday without worrying about food preparation and service.

### **KOSHER LITE - Self supervised by guests, no Mashgiach**

- ZAR 600 per person per night surcharge for all Milchik, Fleischik and Parev ingredients.
- ZAR 9,000 per Kosher equipment Milk/Meat kit. Includes replacements of new pots and pans only.

### **KOSHER STRICT - A Jewish chef and Mashgiach work with the local team (for larger family groups) \*\***

- ZAR 600 per person per night surcharge for all Milchik, Fleischik and Parev ingredients.
- ZAR 50,000 for a FULL new Kosher equipment kit. Includes replacements of new pots, pans, baking trays, braai grids and crockery.
- ZAR 4,300 per day for a private Kosher chef (excluding flights, transfers and accommodation costs).
- ZAR 3,300 per day for a Mashgiach supervisor (excluding flights, transfers and accommodation costs).

\* At the Royal Residences, Kosher offerings are only possible if 2 residences are booked (one dairy kitchen and one meat kitchen)
