GENERAL INFORMATION

THE VESSEL - Outeniqua Peroni Yacht, a 50 foot (14.8mtr) Sloop Yacht with a fixed keel measuring a depth of 1.9 metre. This one of kind, 13 ton yacht was built in Plettenberg Bay and launched in Knysna in 1998 by the current owner of Spring Tide Charters, Mr Steff Pepler. The vessel boasts a 21 metre mast with a 4 metre beam and teak deck. Below deck, guests have access to on board rest rooms and the deck is spacious and comfortable to accommodate 12 passengers while experiencing sailing along our pristine coastline.

SEATING - The yacht has a capacity of 12 passengers plus crew and while the crew take the helm, our guests have various options to sit back and enjoy the splendour of our rugged coastline. Our stern seating rail is perfect for observing the surroundings and the crew at work and the bow deck area is great to lay back and relax and soak in some vitamin-SEA.

BOARDING – The Outeniqua can be found moored at the Knysna Quays alongside Dry Dock Restaurant. A remote-controlled bridge is lowered from the quay side on to the stern of the yacht where passengers can board easily. Passengers are required to remove their shoes before stepping on to the deck. Once everyone has boarded and seated our skipper will raise the bridge and depart from the waterfront.

PASSENGERS – The crew are at your every beck and call! Our crew will provide you with menus for our cash bar. The bar has a variety of beverages available and a tab will be run by the crew that can be settled at the end of the charter. Passengers are required to put on a SAMSA approved ultra-lightweight inflatable Laliza Sigma life jacket before proceeding through the Knysna Heads. The Skipper will instruct our deckhands to prepare the clients before heading out to sea. The life jackets are removed once the yacht comes back from sea and the crew will then prepare the aft deck for the Mediterranean spread of finger foods, breads and dips.

CATERING – A delicious Mediterranean spread of finger foods, breads and spreads are laid out on the aft deck once the yacht has returned from its adventure beyond the heads. The spread of finger foods includes – veg spring rolls, samosa's, crumbed prawns, peppadew stuffed with feta, smoked chicken slices, olives and

sundried tomato. Passengers are asked to advise before the trip if there is any dietary requirements or allergies that we need to consider so everyone is included.
