



BRENTON ON SEA EXCELLENT FOR SWIMMING & BEACH WALKS (Swimming is only advisable when lifeguard on duty) BRENTON ON SEA | 16 KM | 30 MINUTES DRIVE

Home of the famous "Brenton Blue" Butterfly, Brenton on Sea nestles between the Indian Ocean and the hills of Knysna's Western Head. It's golden sands are perfect for walking, sunbathing and fishing. From the cliff top paths, schools of dolphins and whales can be easily spotted



BUFFEL'S BAY | THE FERFECT DAY OUT EXCELLENT FOR SWIMMING & BEACH WALKS (Swimming is only advisable when lifeguard on duty) BUFFEL'S BAY I 20 KM I 35 MINUTES DRIVE

With fine, sandy beaches stretching all the way to Brenton on Sea, it offers beautiful views and breathtaking sunsets. Buffalo Bay is a family beach with safe swimming and excellent surfing conditions, including a "wild side". Perfect for long walks, beach fishing and whale & dolphin spotting.



NOETZIE BEACH NATURE RESERVE EXCELLENT FOR BEACH WALKS NOETZIE I 11 KM I 30 MINUTES DRIVE ON GRAVEL ROAD (100 steps down to beach from parking lot)

Noetzie is one of those places that people remember. For many it is because of the "castles", which have intrigued visitors over the years, and the first question nearly every visitor asks is: "Who built them?" But what really makes Noetzie so special are not the castles, but its natural beauty, much of which is still pristine.







GARDEN OF EDEN INTRODUCTORY EASY WALK TO THE KNYSNA FOREST HAKERVILLE AREA I 10 KM I 15 MINUTES DRIVE

This area of indigenous forest forms part of the larger Knysna Indigenous Forest complex. Forest mammals are usually hidden but tracks of bushbuck, blue duiker, porcupine, caracal, honey badger, porcupine, baboon and vervet monkey may be seen. There are some 40 species of forest birds, including the Knysna loerie. The trail is level and crosses a number of rustic bridges. There is an 800 m "Wheelchair Route" for the physically handicapped. This site was first opened in 1926.



KING EDWARD VII BIG TREE STARTING POINT TO THE KNYSNA ELEPHANT WALKS DIEPWALLE FOREST I 24 KM I 45 MINUTES ON GRAVEL

Knysna's history is interwoven with its rich indigenous forests. For many years the forests were mercilessly robbed of its rich resources. Extensive destruction of the forests occurred due to indiscriminate harvesting of timber. Fortunately, measures were put into place to preserve and maintain the forests: the indigenous state-owned southern Cape forests were closed from 1939 to 1967 to allow regeneration. Today the forests are managed according to strict conservation principles and harvesting is done in a responsible and ecological sensitive manner.



VALLEY OF THE FERNS FURTHER UP ALONG THE ROAD FROM THE BIG TREE, GENTLE WALK AMONG THE FERNS

DIEPWALLE FOREST I 35 KM I 1 HOUR DRIVE ON GRAVELThe Valley of Ferns is situated on the road between

Ine Valley of Ferns is situated on the road between Knysna and Uniondale, approximately 10 km after the Diepwalle forest station. It offers a pleasant, tranquil picnic site and a short walk through the grove of ferns. Stinkwood trees, Ironwood, Red Alder and the Forest Elder may also be seen here.







7 PASSES ROAD KNYSNA TO GEORGE I 75 KM I 2 HOURS DRIVE ON MIXED TAR & GRAVEL

This 75 km historic road was completed in 1883. Rivers generally flow in deep gorges on their way from the mountains to the sea, therefore there are seven passes along the way, hence the name of the route. Before the Passes Road were constructed, there was no good overland route between George and Knysna. It was the main road between George and Knysna for almost 70 years, until the National Road (N2) was completed in 1952.



PLETTENBERG BAY I BAIA FORMOSA PLETTENBERG I 30 KM I 40 MINUTES DRIVE

Plettenberg Bay is the jewel of The Garden Route. It's more than a village, less than a town and is tranquil and charming, hospitable and rather special. Plett (as locals call it) is characterized by sweeping uns-poilt golden beaches, a dramatic rocky peninsula and intriguing lagoons.





The Robberg Peninsula is a nature reserve and national monument that lies about 8km south of Plettenberg Bay. The ecology of the Robberg Peninsula is similar to that of other rocky headlands on this coastline. It presents a fine example of how plants and animals adapt to the interacting influences of land and sea. Robberg offers a choice of three walking trails and the famous Nelson's Bay Caves.



KLEIN KAROO I OUDTSHOORN FULL DAY TRIP

Itinerary: Knysna I George I Outeniqua Pass I Ostrich Farm I Cango Caves I Summit of the Swartberg Pass (Die Top) I Oudtshoorn I George I Knysna



Distance: Approximately **344 kilometers I 9 Hours and 30 Minutes** (**5 hours of driving and 4 hours and 30 minutes** of amazing attractions. (Distances and Drive Times are approximate)



The Klein Karoo or Little Karoo is a long valley bordered by the Swartberg Mountains to the north and the Langeberg / Outeniqua Mountains to the south. This is the land of succulents - their thick, fleshy diversity unparalleled anywhere else in the world. Visitors testify of the regions distinctive geology, the friendliness of its people and the mystique of the landscape. Today the Ostrich Farms, together with the Cango Caves - a series of subterranean chambers - are the main draws to the region, but it is the Swartberg Pass - rated one of the most spectacular drives in Africa - the unique sandstone architecture and the Afrikaans ambience of the Towns that makes no Garden Route itinerary complete without a visit to the Klein Karoo.

Enjoy the relaxed, and hospitable atmosphere offered in the area. Some of the attractions In the Klein Karoo and around Oudtshoorn are:

The Cango Caves: One of the worlds great natural wonders, sculptured by nature through the ages. It is situated close to Town of Oudtshoorn. Mysterious and breathtaking limestone formations in a wide variety of natural colours, a subterranean wonderland. Regular guided tours daily.

The Ostriches: Amidst the 400 ostrich farms surrounding the town, there are several distinguished "show farms". Become exposed to this exotic bird species, the largest in the world. Guided tours available.

Crocodiles: Gaze with the awe at the slithering reptiles' species from all over the world. Imagine... more than 400 crocodiles and alligators in their prehistoric unattractiveness. They're being bred here and they're awfully nice, as long as you don't get too close!

Cheetahs: A highly successful breeding station of this threatened species, one of the only two in the southern hemisphere. You can get yourself photographed cuddling a cheetah cub, the fastest animal on land.





TSITSIKAMMA NATIONAL PARK & SURROUINDINGS FULL DAY TRIP

Itinerary: Knysna I Garden of Eden I Knysna Elephant Park I Plettenberg Bay I The Crags I Nature Valley I Bloukrans Bridge I Tsitsikamma National Park I Knysna

Distance: Approximately **200 kilometers I 6 Hours** (2 hours and **30 minutes driving and 3 hours and 30 minutes** of amazing attractions. (Distances and Drive Times are approximate)

The Tsitsikamma National Park is situated at the heart of the picturesque tourist region known as the Garden Route, found in the Southern Cape of South Africa. Tsitsikamma is a Khoisan word meaning, "place of much water". The Park incorporates 80 km of rocky coastline with spectacular sea and landscapes, a remote mountainous region with secluded valleys covered in mountain Fynbos and temperate high forests with deep river gorges leading down to the sea.

The Tsitsikamma's spectacular scenery includes the Indian Ocean breakers, pounding rocky shores beneath 180 m high cliffs, ever-green forests and fynbos (proteas and heath) rolling down to the sea in a lush carpet where ancient rivers have carved their path to the ocean through rocky ravines. All this conspires to attract large numbers of international and local tourist to the Park.

Tsitsikamma National Park protects a wonderland of inter-tidal and marine life. This is one of the largest single unit 'no take' (including fishing) Marine Protected Areas in the world, conserving 11% of South Africa's Temperate South Coast rocky shoreline and provides a 'laboratory' for fisheries baseline research on endangered fish species. In 1964 when it was proclaimed, it became the first Marine National Park to be proclaimed in Africa.
