







GETTING TO US

SOUTH LUANGWA

Commonly known as the 'Valley of the Leopard', South Luangwa is regarded as one of the worlds greatest wildlife sanctuaries.

Kaingo and Mwamba are located deep within the remote North of the park in an area renowned for its varied landscapes and exceptional game viewing.


























Come together

We pride ourselves on being a wifi-free location, come to us to disconnect.




Over-bed fans are supplied in each room

With plumbed cold water, the hot water is delivered in bucket showers. All hot water is heated with slow-burning, fallen wood. We cut no trees.







































































GIVING BACK I Our community
