Livingstone Island





Livingstone Island is located on the edge of Victoria Falls and is the very spot where Dr David Livingstone famously stated, "Scenes so lovely, must have been gazed upon by angels in their flight."

The island is managed by Green Safaris and this experience is truly unmissable. Guests are transported to the island by boat, where an expert guide will meet you, imparting knowledge about this equally beautiful and historic destination.

Unique to the Zambian side of the falls, guests can safely swim in Devil's Pool, a naturally occurring rock pool on the edge of the waterfall, and have the thrilling opportunity to look over the very edge as thousands of litres of water spill over into the abyss below.

A very seasonal activity, access depends entirely on the Zambezi River levels. Devil's Pool is usually open between mid-August and late December, and the island is open a little longer on both sides of that.

Swimming is never guaranteed – please always check the river levels with our team in advance.

Bring bathing suits, sunblock, hats, water shoes (available to rent). Towels will be provided. There is a lockable trunk on the island to lock away valuables and bathrooms to change. There is a shop at the launch site as well as well as coffee and alcoholic drinks for purchase at the launch site. A sumptuous meal provided during your selected slot (not on Walking tour). Bring your water bottle, camera, and sunglasses along. Only strong swimmers allowed to do swimming activities. Minimum Age: 8 years old for the island; 12 years old for Devil's Pool / Angel's Pool and Walking tour.

Livingstone Island Walking Tour

Walk from the Eastern Cataract (the Zambian side), across the dry parts of Vic Falls, to Livingstone Island in the very centre of the waterfall. Soft drinks are supplied on the island and guests have the opportunity to take a dip. Please wear shoes that can get wet and are non-slippery. Opens 1st August to 31st December - dependant on water levels.

Horse Riding

A tranquil way to experience the bush and travel along the Zambezi River.

What to wear: Long trousers or jeans and an old shirt, closed shoes preferably with a heel. Riding hats will be provided.

Important: Proof of Medical aid is compulsory for all riders (bring photocopy).

Quad Biking

Zoom through the bush on four wheels, twisting and turning along the jeep tracks.

Microlight Flight

An activity for people who wish they had wings, a microlight is entirely open, with the wind and even the spray from the Falls in your face. Benjamin Parker (Tongabezi co-founder), quite famously first landed on the Zambezi River piloting a microlight equipped with floats. At Tongabezi, we have never quite lost our love of microlights, and Batoka Sky still uses the very same microlight that Ben once flew!

- Please note that flights are based on availability and weather.
- Use of personal camera equipment is prohibited.
- A Go-Pro is mounted on the craft, and a USB stick with stills and video is available to buy after your flight for an additional \$40.

Helicopter Flights

Gaze upon the Falls from above. A flight over the Falls includes the chance to see wildlife from above. We advise our guests to indulge in the extra cost to do the slightly longer flight through the winding gorges below the waterfall. You can thank us later.

Gorge Activities

The gorges below the Falls don't get nearly enough attention considering how awe-inspiring they are. Spend some time here if you're keen on jumping, diving or abseiling (any sort of controlled falling, really).

A special recommendation: When Benjamin Parker's nephews came out from the UK on their first visit, this was the first activity he took them to (his daughters were heartbroken as they were too small at the time and had to miss out on all the fun!)

- Minimum age is 14 years for bungee activities; minimum age is 7 years for other gorge activities.

White Water Rafting

The gorges below Victoria Falls boast impressive Grade 5 rapids with names such as The Terminator, Oblivion, The Washing Machine, Judgement Day, and even the Devil's Toilet Bowl!

The fluctuating water levels of the Zambezi result in high and low water seasons. Be sure to ask our team what this means for your rafting experience.

At minimal extra cost you can walk/swim underneath the Victoria Falls before you go on the rafting trip.

- Do wear comfortable shoes for the walk out of the gorge.
- Some level of fitness is required!
- Minimum age is 15 years old.

Chobe Day Trip

Tongabezi is not a Big 5 game destination. Chobe is your closest and best bet. The Chobe National Park also boasts the world's largest elephant population.

It just takes a quick hop over our quadripoint border, and you can find the Famous 5: ask your guide about the Small 5 and the Ugly 5. A boat cruise on the Chobe River will bring the wildlife up close and, in the afternoon, you will head deeper into the park for a game drive to spot Africa's elusive big cats.

- Departure 07.00 and return 17.00.

Zimbabwean Side Falls Tour



Simonga Village Tour

Visit our nearest traditional village, where a local villager will act as your guide. This is a unique opportunity for the village to share their culture with you. You will be able to interact and converse and find out more about our traditional village lifestyle.

- Pictures are allowed but always request before doing so.
- A possibility to bike, walk or drive.
- The tour will last 45 minutes to an hour.

Sunrise & Sunset Cruises

Explore the Zambezi river just before the sun rises and see how Africa wakes up in the early hours of the morning or relax and watch the wildlife get ready for the night as the African sun sets. This is a fantastic way to see numerous wildlife and birdlife.

Mukuni Community Farm

Come and explore some of our 12.6 hectares of sweetveld (nutritious vegetation), which is rapidly becoming a fully sustainable, organic community-run farm. Our team absolutely loves to teach travellers about sustainable farming techniques, from alley cropping to grazing rotation and even to the home-made fertiliser and organic pesticide that are used. This difference is what motivates the community to also adopt methods that are not only cheaper and better for the environment but also provide a higher harvest yield. The Mukuni Community farm is on your way to Victoria Falls, so it is best to combine the tour with other town-based activities.


Tongabezi Strength

The gym has a television to pass time as well as Google Chrome to allow guests to cast their own workout app on the television. Heated workouts come naturally here thanks to Zambia's warm climate! Guests have access to a toilet and shower room to freshen up after their workout.

Lunar Rainbow

For three days during the full moon when the Zambezi River is high, a Lunar Rainbow can be experienced over Victoria Falls. This is when the moon is bright enough to reflect in the spray from the waterfall and is a truly unforgettable sight. April to August tends to be the best time for moonbows.

Fishing

There are numerous species of fish to be found in the Zambezi River and you have the opportunity to cast your line towards them. This is another opportunity to see the hippos, countless birdlife and other wildlife while being on the river, too.

- Departing at 08.30 and 14:30.

- Fishing is banned on the Zambezi River from 01 December to 1 March each year

Island Picnic Lunch

Take a riveting boat ride to an island that has been specially picked out by our guides and enjoy a 3-course menu in the bush surrounded by the Zambezi. You will have the opportunity of seeing elephants, hippos, impala and different birdlife. Your valet and boat guide will be on hand if you have any questions.

Twaabane Creative Centre

Twaabane Creative Centre provides highquality vocational training to improve access to income-generating opportunities and ultimately promote social and economic development in Simonga. Guests can visit and learn about the centre's story, vision and values, enjoy a site tour and meet the trainers and trainees.

Organic Garden Tour

The Tongabezi tennis courts have been transformed into our veggie and herb garden with an array of herbs, citrus fruits, seasonal tropical fruits as well as vegetables and salad ingredients.

The groundsmen use suitable kitchen waste such as tea bags, coffee grounds and ash from our fire pits and recycle it into usable compost. You will be shown around by one of our groundsmen and your valet. The tour duration is all up to you and how long you would like to look around.

You can even Harvest Your Plate where you can pick your own vegetables for a light lunch prepared to you in the garden.

Cycling & MTB

The ranges that you can cycle go from 5km to 100km, short or long our guides know some great on and off-road tracks. The border is your limit!

Game Drives

Encounter a variety of wildlife in Mosi-Oa-Tunya National Park from the comfort of an open vehicle driven by an experienced and knowledgeable guide. The park is home to elephants, giraffe, wildebeest, zebra, buffalo and bushbuck, among many other animals and birdlife. While driving near the banks of the Zambezi River, look out for waterbuck, hippos and crocodiles. There are no big predators in the park.

Livingstone Markets

Museums in Livingstone

There are 3 different museums to visit. The Livingstone, The Railway and the Field Museum.

The Livingstone is located in the centre of town with artefacts from the stone age to David Livingstone's personal effects.

The Railway Museum is located just out of town on route to the falls, and it is a perfect stop for those train enthusiasts.

The Field Museum is situated next to the falls and has a visual description of how the falls were formed.

Visit Victoria Falls

Stroll along the Zambian edge of the Victoria Falls, one of the 7 natural wonders of the world. Surrounded by rainforests, looking down into the gorge at the rainbows that the falls create. While at the falls, the guides can lead you down to the famous boiling pot (but don't forget the walk up!). Once completing the falls tour, guides will let you choose if you would like to go have a look at the Livingstone veggie market and craft market. Ponchos provided.
