INCLUSIVE **ACTIVITIES**

SNORKELLING

Discover the crystal-clear waters of Lake Malawi, ideal for snorkelers of all levels. Kaya Mawa provides snorkels, goggles, and fins. Boat trips to nearby snorkelling spots can be arranged for USD \$25 per person per hour.

SAILING

Experience a serene sailing safari on one of our Taz or Topaz sailboats. The lake's calm waters and steady breeze make for a smooth and enjoyable journey.




KAYAKING

Explore the surrounding waters and hidden island spots by kayak. Paddle alongside vibrant fish, soak in the views of the Mozambican coastline, and enjoy the tranquillity of nature.

Glide across the water on a stand-up paddleboard. With boards readily available on the beach, this activity is great for all skill levels.





BIRDING


Venture into the island's lush forests to observe its vibrant birdlife, or simply enjoy the company of visiting feathered friends while sipping your morning coffee. Likoma Island boasts over 100 bird species, including impressive colonies of white-breasted cormorants, black-shouldered and yellow-billed kites, and four types of kingfishers. The call of the African fish eagle is a particularly captivating sound you'll never tire of.

CHEFS TOUR OF OUR COMMUNITY GARDEN

Request a guided tour of our on-site community garden from our lodge managers, where our chefs draw inspiration from seasonal, organic produce. During the tour, you'll discover the essentials of soil quality, composting, planting cover crops, mulching, and collecting baobab fibres from fallen trees. Our team will further explain farm management principles and environmentally friendly practices. This initiative not only fosters employment but also promotes alternative agriculture and chemical-free farming.

SECRET LOOKOUT SPOT

Just a short walk from our main area, tucked discreetly within the island's lush vegetation, lies a hidden lookout spot you won't want to miss. Here, you can take in breathtaking views of the sun setting over the lodge and the expansive lake. It's also an ideal location for birdwatching or enjoying a sundowner. Feel free to ask our team for directions or to arrange your favourite drinks for a perfect evening.




LIVE SUNDOWNER MUSIC

PADI DIVING

We are a PADI-certified lodge offering a range of diving options and courses for all levels. Enquire for full details.

SPA TREATMENTS

Relax at Kaya Spa, located on a rocky outcrop connected by a wooden boardwalk. Treatments start from USD \$60.

WATERSKIING AND WAKEBOARDING

Try your hand at one or both of these exhilarating water sports. With skis that fit ages 5+ and handy tips and pointers, you will be on your feet or knees in no time.



ISLAND DRIVES

Tour Likoma Island by vehicle, including stops at St. Peter's Cathedral, the Katundu Workshop, and the vibrant local town. Cost: USD \$60 per person.

*ST PETER'S CATHEDRAL

St. Peter's Cathedral is a striking landmark on Likoma Island, built between 1903 and 1911. As one of the oldest and most significant Christian structures in Malawi, it showcases the Gothic Revival architecture designed by British architect George Frederick Bodley—an unusual and impressive style for the region. Erected by the Anglican Church to further its mission, the cathedral features stunning stained-glass windows, intricate woodwork, and remarkable stonework, creating a grand and peaceful ambience. Beyond being a place of worship, St. Peter's Cathedral serves as a historical and cultural icon for both locals and visitors. It provides a window into Malawi's colonial past and the lasting impact of missionary work in the area. Visitors are warmly invited to experience this sacred space and, if lucky, enjoy the beautiful sounds of the church choir on Sundays. Please dress modestly.



KATUNDU WORKSHOP

Katundu Workshop provides sustainable income for the local community, especially women, through artisanal training, and is proudly supported by our Green Safaris Conservation Foundation. The focus is on using locally sourced, upcycled materials to craft beautiful interior décor. In the rooms, houses, and main areas of Kaya Mawa, you'll find striking pieces handmade by the talented artisans at Katundu. This approach ensures that discarded materials from the lodge are transformed into unique creations rather than being recycled or, worse, discarded. Visit this vibrant space to browse items for your own home, or take part in a crafty workshop, led by these inspiring creatives. Ask our lodge managers to arrange a short drive (or cycle) to the workshop.


*HANDMADE CLOTHING EXPERIENCE

Take a trip to town where our guides will introduce you to skilled local clothing crafters. Here, you can have a completely unique garment created just for you by a talented artisan. DIVE INTO OUR PADI-CERTIFIED OFFERINGS

Our tranquil island haven is surrounded by Lake Malawi's great waters, creating a freshwater playground for guests seeking adventure. Dive into our various PAID-certified diving activities and courses:

DIVING (FOR CERTIFIED DIVERS):

Shore dive: USD \$40 per person Boat dive: USD \$95 per person Night dive: USD \$60 per person Fun Dive: USD \$100 per person

PADI COURSES:

Bubble Makers:

USD \$40 per person

For children between 8-10 years of age and takes about 2 hours to complete.

Experience scuba diving under the direct supervision of a PADI pro. Take your first breaths underwater in water shallower than 2 meters.

PADI SEAL TEAM:

USD \$80 per person

For children from 8 years old and takes about 1 day to complete. The PADI Seal Team program teaches responsibility and respect for the aquatic realm. It's broken into two parts.

DISCOVER SCUBA DIVING:

USD \$110 per person

Minimum age is 10 years old and take about 2-3 hours to complete.

If you're interested in scuba diving, but unsure if you want to enrol in a scuba certification class, Discover Scuba Diving is the perfect way to test the waters. In a very short time, you'll learn basic scuba skills and take your first breaths underwater.

REACTIVATE/REFRESHER COURSE:

USD \$110 per person

Minimum age is 10 years and takes about 2-3 hours to complete. Reactivate is for those who already are certified divers but need to refresh their scuba skills after not diving for 6 months or more.

SCUBA DIVER:

USD \$290 per person

Minimum age is 10 years old and take about 2 days to complete. The PADI Scuba Diver course is a subset of the PADI Open Water Diver course. If you're short on time but really want to become a diver, the PADI Scuba Diver rating might be right for you.

OPEN WATER COURSE:

USD \$490 per person

Minimum age is 10 years old and takes about 3-4 days to complete.

This course will certify you as a licensed scuba diver and you will be able to dive anywhere in the world. This course involves specific knowledge, skills and training with your instructor.

ADVANCED OPEN WATER COURSE:

USD \$550 per person

Minimum age is 12 years old and take about 2-3 days to complete.

The Advanced Open Water Diver course is all about advancing your skills. After some skill practice with your instructor, you'll make five open water dives.

RESCUE DIVER COURSE:

USD \$550 per person

Minimum age is 12 years old and takes between 4 -7 days. This course will change the way you dive – in the best possible way. Learn to identify and fix minor issues before they become big problems, gain a lot of confidence and have serious fun along the way.

EFR COURSE:

USD \$400 per person

No minimum age and take 1 day to complete.

Emergency First Response primary and secondary care training teaches you what to do in the critical moments between when a life-threatening emergency occurs and when emergency medical services arrive.

DIVE MASTER:

USD \$700 per person 18 years and older

Gain practical experience giving dive briefings, assisting with classes and leading underwater tours. Learn how to anticipate problems, help other divers and learn how to be a PADI professional.
