



## KWETSANI CAMP FACTS & INFORMATION | JAO RESERVE

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### WHERE IS KWETSANI CAMP

19° 14.648'S 22° 32.198'E

Kwetsani Camp is a remote luxury camp on a densely wooded island in the Jao Concession (NG25) of Botswana's western Okavango Delta. Raised on stilts, it offers panoramic views of floodplains and permanent waterways.

### WHEN IS A GOOD TIME TO GO

Best time to visit Kwetsani Camp is May - September, May - August (peak flood/dry season) offers high waters for mokoro and boat trips plus excellent game viewing - predators are active and temperatures are mild. September - October sees receding waters and concentrated wildlife around shrinking water sources. November - March (green season) brings lush scenery, abundant birds and calving, though lower water levels favor game drives overboating.

### HOW DO I GET THERE

There are direct international flights to Maun, from where you will take a small charter plane to Kwetsani Camp and the Jao Reserve. Guests reach Kwetsani via Jao Airstrip, then a scenic 60-minute vehicle transfer or, in high water, a 40-minute boat ride to camp.

### WHERE WILL I STAY

Kwetsani Camp offers five intimate, luxurious tree-house chalets elevated on wooden stilts in the Jao Concession, built from canvas, wood and glass with panoramic floodplain views. The airy suites feature king (or twin) beds with mosquito nets, over-bed air conditioning, a lounge area, ceiling fan, safe, coffee tea station, en-suite bathrooms with double basins, flush toilets and indoor plus private outdoor showers, verandas and private viewing decks. A family room is also available.

### WHAT WILL I EAT

At Kwetsani Camp meals are all-inclusive with three daily sittings: a light early breakfast, a hearty post activity brunch, afternoon tea and a three-course dinner. Dining features plated starters and desserts with buffet-style mains. Dietary needs can be catered with advance

notice. Meals are served in the raised open-air dining area or boma, with complimentary alcoholic and non-alcoholic drinks and snacks available throughout the day.

### FULLY INCLUSIVE RATE INCLUDES

Airstrip transfers, all meals, daily activities (some exclusions apply), local drinks and laundry are included. Excluded are flights, discretionary tips/gratuities, personal items and personal travel insurance.

### WHAT ARE THE FACILITIES

The raised thatched main lodge - linked by wooden walkways - houses a bar built around a jackalberry tree, lounge with a small library, dining area and a pool. Amenities include complimentary laundry and a curio shop; the reimagined camp is 100% solar-powered.

### WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW

Children of all ages are welcome (see rates for child policies). Tents have 24-hour electricity, with in-room charging and camp Wi-Fi. Game vehicles are open-rooftop and seat up to seven guests.

### WHAT WILL I DO HERE

At Kwetsani Camp you'll enjoy a mix of water and land safaris: seasonal mokoro and motorboat trips, game drives (often to predator-rich Hunda Island), guided bush walks, birding, seasonal fishing (Mar - Dec), and optional scenic helicopter flights.
