- All currently applicable taxes, national park fees, and conservancy fees are included in this quote unless otherwise noted. Please note that taxes and fees are determined by the government of Tanzania and are thus subject to increase.
- Please note that your itinerary includes time in malarial areas and that anti-malaria precautions are necessary.
- Please note that Tanzania falls into the yellow fever region in Africa. It is imperative for all travellers to obtain a yellow fever vaccination no less than 10 days prior to travel. Please note that your country of origin and other African countries may deny entry without proof of vaccination after having visited a country with yellow fever.
Please ensure that you obtain your vaccination prior to travel and that you bring your vaccination certificate with you.
- The baggage allowance on light air transfers in Tanzania is restricted to 15 kg per person (including carry-on luggage and photographic/video equipment) in a soft bag. Any excess luggage may involve the use of an extra aircraft to carry such luggage and will result in you being liable for this additional cost, which must be settled directly.
 - If you would like to increase your luggage allowance (e.g. you are a serious photographer and would like to bring a substantial amount of camera gear) it is possible to book a ‘cargo seat’ at additional cost. Please let us know if you would like to book a cargo seat.
- Please note that luggage on light air transfers must be packed in soft bags (dufflebags) with no wheels or frames due to the size of the small planes’ luggage compartments. A collapsible wheeled luggage cart/trolley is allowed as long as its dimensions are similar to those of the bag. The maximum bag size is 25 cm wide x 30 cm high x 62 cm long (10 in wide x 12 in high x 24 in long).
 - If you have luggage you will not need for the light air transfer portion of your journey, we can arrange storage at most airports for a nominal cost.
- Light air transfers in Tanzania are booked on a seat basis. Please note that other guests may be picked up or dropped off en-route to your destination. If you would prefer direct flights, it is possible to book a private charter at additional cost.
