Between July and October, the plains come alive as around 1.5 million wildebeest, accompanied by vast herds of zebra and other herbivores, make their spectacular annual migration from Tanzania's Serengeti. Outside of migration season, the Mara remains one of Africa's finest year-round safari destinations, offering exceptional game viewing and an abundance of wildlife.

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## Day 1-3: Sweetwaters Serena Camp, Ol Pejeta Conservancy

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Pick up from your Nairobi hotel/ airport and transfer by road to the heart of Ol Pejeta Conservancy, home to Kenya's Big Five. (drive is 210kms/ +- 4 hrs)

Resting at the foothills of Mount Kenya and the Aberdare Mountain Range, in central Kenya's Laikipia County, the Ol Pejeta Conservancy is the largest black rhino sanctuary in East Africa. It is also home to some of the last remaining northern white rhino in the world. Originally a working cattle ranch in colonial Kenya and now a pioneering wildlife conservancy, Ol Pejeta works to protect wildlife and provide a sanctuary for rescued chimpanzees.

Nestled in the vast **Ol Pejeta Conservancy**, and surrounded by gorgeous views of Mount Kenya, Sweetwaters Serena Camp presents sophisticated tented accommodation and a tranquil respite in wilderness that is home to the “Big Five”. Enjoy delicious meals with global flavours and scenic views at the Rhino Restaurant, where much of the cuisine is sourced directly from the local communities surrounding the reserve.

The Water Hotel bar is a relaxing spot for enjoying a drink while gazing down to the game enjoying a drink of their own. At night you can cosy up here beside the roaring fire and wind down your day with a nightcap under star-splashed skies.

The spacious standard tents blend the ambiance of a traditional safari camp with the comforts of home. Featuring thatched roofs, solid floors and canvas interiors, they lead onto an ensuite bathroom with shower. All have a private veranda or balcony overlooking the waterhole complete the set up.

There's a host of experiences to enhance your stay: scenic bird walks along the river, camel rides, bush dining, lion tracking, visit to a chimp sanctuary and night game drives. Experience horse riders should book a guided ride through herds of endangered Gravy's zebra and Jackson's hartebeest to spot the last remaining northern white rhinos on the planet.

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## Day 3-4: Flamingo Hill Tented Camp, Lake Nakuru National Park

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Early morning departure and drive to Lake Nakuru National Park in Kenya's Great Rift Valley. (Drive is 160kms/ +- 3.5 hrs)

**Lake Nakuru National Park** is home to exceptional birdlife, as well as over 50 varieties of mammals including lion, leopard, buffalo, zebra, giraffe, rhino, antelope and various primates.

### Overnight: Flamingo Hill Tented Camp x 2 nights

Enjoy morning and afternoon game drives, exceptional bird watching and nature walks for the more active guest.

Flamingo Hill Camp is situated within the famous Lake Nakuru National Park, which lies within the Great Rift Valley of Kenya. Nestled between the "honeymoon hills" and set in beautifully landscaped grounds with natural foliage and a variety of indigenous African plants and flowers, Flamingo Hill Camp provides superb, tented accommodation.

It is an eco-friendly establishment, with income from the camp used for environmental restoration and protection of endangered species.



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## Day 5-7: Basecamp Masai Mara, Masai Mara

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Depart after breakfast to Nairobi for your flight from Wilson Airport to the Masai Mara (Road transfer 150kms/ +- 3hrs)

The **Masai Mara** together with Tanzania's Serengeti form Africa's most famous wildlife park, the Masai Mara National Reserve. The highlight of the Masai Mara National Reserve is undoubtedly the annual wildebeest migration traversing the vast plains of the Serengeti and the Masai Mara. It is known as the largest mass movement of land mammals on the planet – with more than a million animals following the rains. Large prides of lions, herds of elephants, as well as giraffes, gazelles and eland can also be spotted in the reserve. Aside from horse riding safaris and traditional vehicle safaris, hot-air ballooning over the Mara plains has become almost essential.

### Overnight: Basecamp Masai Mara x 3 nights

Morning and afternoon game drives in a shared vehicle to be enjoyed during your stay in the Mara Reserve.

Basecamp Masai Mara offers 17 spacious and luxurious Riverside Tents. The tents are built along the banks of the Talek River, the natural border to the Masai Mara National Reserve. The dense riverbed foliage allows for maximum privacy and comfort, without compromising the view of the Masai Mara National Reserve just a stone throw away. With more than 300 identified bird species, you are certain to wake to a symphony of birdsong while staying at Basecamp Masai Mara.

Next to Basecamp Masai Mara is the Enjoolata Awareness Centre where guests are invited into exhibitions, movies, photo editing and face-to-face meetings with the Maasais providing a deeper understanding to anyone who seeks knowledge about this fascinating culture and place.



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## Day 8: Tamarind Tree Hotel, Nairobi

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Depart after breakfast for your return flight back to Nairobi and transfer to Tamarind Tree Hotel for overnight.

## **PASSPORT AND VISAS**

All visitors to Kenya must be in possession of a valid passport, which must be valid for 6 months after return date of travel and have at least 3 blank pages in it.

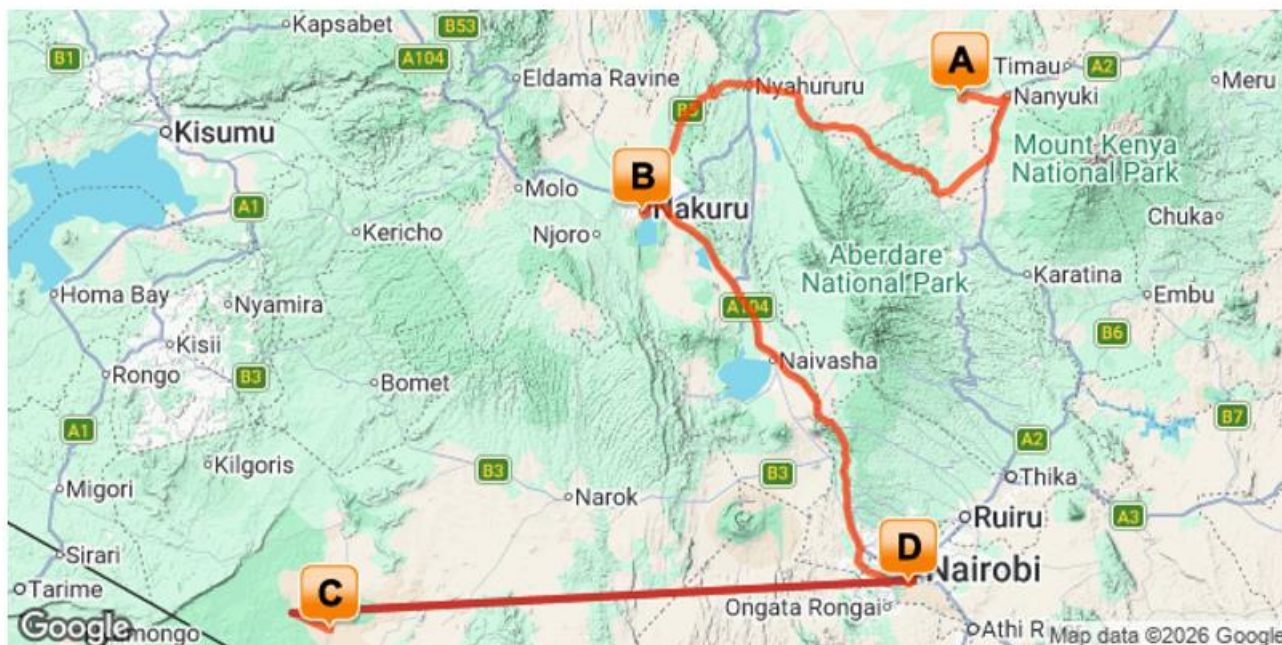
An evisa can be obtained via the Electronic Travel Authorization (eTA) system at a cost of \$30. Successful applicants will be issued their approved eTA in 3 days, but travellers are encouraged to process their eTA 3 months in advance, it will be valid for 90 days and is applicable to 1 visit to Kenya. Any visitor to Kenya must have their eTA approved before their journey starts. To apply for the ETA visit <https://www.etakenya.go.ke/en>. *Note: nationals from South Africa do not have to pay the eTA fee.*

## **HEALTH REQUIREMENTS**

**A Yellow Fever inoculation is compulsory.** Should you require one, this must be done no later than 10 days prior to your departure. Tetanus inoculation is also recommended.
