

PACKING LIST FOR SAFARI



As a rule, lightweight, light coloured clothing is preferable. Avoid synthetic materials and black clothing, as they increase perspiration and discomfort. Garments of neutral colours that blend with the bush and forest are advisable for safaris and game viewing particularly when walking.

On Safari

- 2 pairs of long trousers or shorts, three shirts, preferably long sleeved and collared, natural colours
- At least two casual clothes for evening wear. Trousers for men are recommended for dinner
- A light fleece for morning and evening game drives.
- 3 pairs of socks (cotton)
- Swimsuit and sarong
- A lightweight waterproof jacket (preferably GORETEX or the equivalent) in case of rain
- 1 pair of flip flops/sandals for the afternoons and evening
- 1 hat that can shade face and neck
- 2 pairs of light pants/jeans
- 2 T-shirts
- Underwear (sports bras recommended) – Note the staff do not wash underwear
- Tracksuit pants/leggings for the morning
- Belt and scarf

Sundries



- Head torch with spare batteries
- Sunglasses and an extra pair of prescription glasses if necessary
- Binoculars and camera
- Cash for curios and tips (smaller denomination notes for tipping)
- Travel Insurance information kept on hand
- Money pouch, please ask your guide to keep your valuables
- Dry bags or jumbo zip lock bags for dirty or wet clothes or to keep clothes dry
- Finger less gloves or hand warmers (optional)
- International power adaptors
- Plenty of max factor sunscreen
- Lip balm with sunscreen
- Shampoo, hand sanitizer, tissue, or wet wipes
- Moisturiser or Vaseline as the air is very dry
- Small insect repellent (the camps do have these, but if you want your own)
- Small first aid kit with Antihistamine cream and tablets, antiseptic cream, band aids, eye drops, Paracetamol, Rehydrate salts, anti-diarrhoea medication, motion sickness pills and personal medication
- Bring an extra small ruck sack for the day

Please note

- **Pack everything in a soft bag, no hard bags. There is a 15 kg /33 lb luggage limit including hand luggage. Extra luggage allowance can be arranged at an extra cost**
- Do not travel with expensive jewellery
- Some camps do not have hairdryers due to electricity supply
- **As a final comment, a daily laundry service is provided at the Lodges (except smalls), and is included, so no need to pack too much**
