With so many of Africa's majestic animals on the endangered species list, there has never been a more crucial time to support wildlife. As well as our daily contributions to government agencies, Asilia donates over US\$100,000 annually to a variety of conservation initiatives, with a focus on the continent's predators.

One of our key partners in conservation is Kenya Wildlife Trust (KWT), which has focused on creating sustainable predator populations in Kenya since 2007. KWT's predator conservation work in the Mara is implemented by its Mara Predator Conservation Programme (MPCP). A morning or afternoon visit

to MPCP's Tony Lapham Predator Hub offers guests an insight into the challenges and successes of their conservation and community projects, community drives within the conservancy and engaging primary schools with Wildlife Clubs alongside Asilia's own Twende Porini.

A trip to MPCP is often paired with a visit to another one of Asilia Giving's implementing partners, Maa Trust, based just next door.
