Airport transfer from Kilimanjaro as needed.

Arrive Arusha, with site inspections if time allows.

Overnight at Arusha Coffee Lodge, B&B

Day 2 – 25 October

From Arusha, fly to Kogatende (Serengeti North) for two nights.

Overnight at Serengeti North Wilderness Camp, full board inclusive of house drinks.

Day 3 – 26 October

Serengeti North lodge & camp inspections / game drives.

Drive from Serengeti North to central Serengeti for two nights. Camp and lodge inspections enroute.

Overnight Serengeti Wilderness Camp (Nyabogati area), full board inclusive of house drinks.

Serengeti Balloon Safari – Serengeti North



Enjoy a thrilling bird's eye view as you gracefully soar above the teeming plains and rocky outcrops of the norther section of the Serengeti National Park, with views of the Mara River. You will be collected from your lodge/camp and transferred to the launch site. The balloon safari starts at 06h00 and lasts for approximately one hour. You'll be met on landing and transferred to enjoy a sumptuous full English bush breakfast, complete with sparkling wine. Transfer back to camp/continue on safari.
