Day 1: Victoria Falls Safari Lodge, Victoria Falls (Zimbabwe)

Arrive at Victoria Falls Airport, where you'll be met and transferred to Victoria Falls Safari Lodge for a two-night stay. Settle in and enjoy the lodge's sweeping views over the bush before the vibrant and cultural dining experience at the The Boma – Dinner & Drum Show.

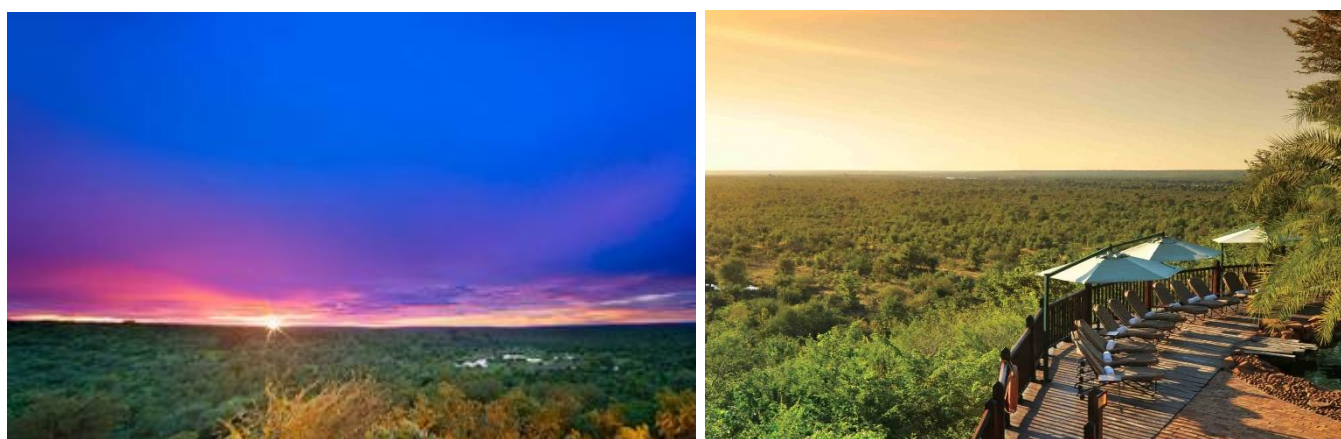
Known locally as Mosi-oa-Tunya— "The Smoke That Thunders"—Victoria Falls is one of the world's great natural landmarks. Straddling the Zambezi River between Zambia and Zimbabwe, it forms a vast curtain of water that fills the air with mist and sound. The Zimbabwean side grants the most dramatic views, where mist rises like ghostly curtains and rainbows arc through the spray. Measuring about 1,708 metres across, it is regarded as the largest single continuous sheet of falling water on Earth. The adjacent town of Victoria Falls provides a convenient base for exploring the region, with a wide range of activities from scenic flights and microlight trips to white-water rafting, bungee jumping, kayaking, and safaris into Chobe National Park.

Built on a plateau overlooking the Zambezi National Park, Victoria Falls Safari Lodge is just 4km from the majestic Victoria Falls and offers a unique wildlife experience.

We're proud to have been voted Best Safari Lodge/ Resort Hotel in Zimbabwe for 23 consecutive years and look forward to welcoming you to our wonderful destination. Our staff are warm and personable and will ensure your holiday is hassle-free.

Built of thatch and timber, the lodge rises several levels, giving the impression of a vast open-plan tree house. Our rooms all have private balconies, most of which overlook a central waterhole, offering the opportunity to observe herds of buffalo, elephant and kudu, as the sun goes down, and hyenas later in the evening.



The Lodge Waterhole Facing Rooms have a balcony with a view overlooking the waterhole and the Zambezi National Park and are sunset facing and have a bathroom with a rain shower and mini bar. Three of the Lodge Waterhole Facing Rooms can accommodate a roller bed for a child under 12 years of age. These rooms can be made up into a king or twin configuration. All rooms are air-conditioned and also have ceiling fans.

The Boma Dinner & Drum Show

Situated within the Victoria Falls Safari Lodge estate, The Boma Dinner & Drum Show is a dining and entertainment experience that offers local dishes, vibrant dance performances, interactive drumming and traditional storytelling. Diners indulge in a four-course meal that includes starters, soup from the campfire, a braai (barbecue) buffet, and a selection of desserts.

Day 2: Victoria Falls Safari Lodge, Victoria Falls (Zimbabwe)

After breakfast, visit the iconic Victoria Falls, one of the Seven Natural Wonders of the World, where you can explore the rainforest trails and viewpoints at your own pace. Enjoy lunch at one of the lodge's restaurants, or head into town for a stroll and choose from a variety of local dining options.

The afternoon is at leisure for optional activities or simply relaxing at the lodge before heading out for a relaxing sundowner cruise on the Zambezi River. End the evening with a delicious dinner, soaking in the atmosphere.

Tour of the Falls Zimbabwe

The Victoria Falls – Now In Its 150 Millionth Fantastic Year - Reaches Its Zenith In About May each year. Once the sun has set and as the skies darken, you'll head back to the Pure Africa Waterfront for a seamless continuation to dinner at The Eatery. Day 3: The Chobe Safari Lodge, Kasane

Tucked away in the northeastern corner of Botswana, on the banks of the famous Chobe River, the scenic little town of Kasane rests on the doorstep of the spectacular Chobe National Park. There are no boundary fences separating the village from the park and game such as elephant and hippo are often spotted roaming around the town. If on the lookout for elusive game, pay a visit to the Sedudu Valley Road, where large dead trees provide temporary homes for leopards. Within Kasane, an ancient baobab tree stands on display, once serving as a local prison. Visitors can look forward to a multitude of activities including enjoying a game drive through the park, taking a sunset cruise down the Chobe River, visiting a local village or jumping on a day trip to the breathtaking Victoria Falls.

Depart Victoria Falls after breakfast and transfer by road to Chobe National Park in Botswana, arriving at Chobe Safari Lodge for a two-night stay. In the afternoon, head out on a scenic boat cruise along the Chobe River, where you'll encounter elephants, hippos, and a variety of birdlife as the sun sets.

The Chobe Safari Lodge is situated in Kasane on the banks of the Chobe River and shares a border with Chobe National Park. Day 4: The Chobe Safari Lodge, Kasane

Between activities, relax at the lodge or take in the riverfront views, rounding off the day with another unforgettable African sunset.

After breakfast, transfer back by road to Victoria Falls Airport for your onward departure, bringing your journey through Victoria Falls and Chobe to a memorable close.
