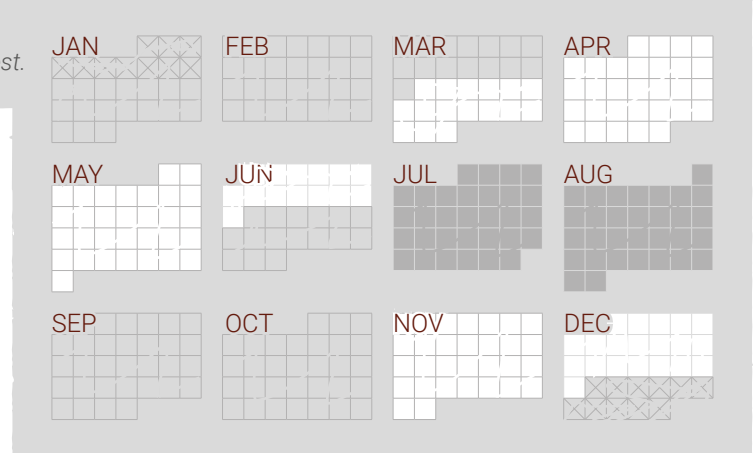

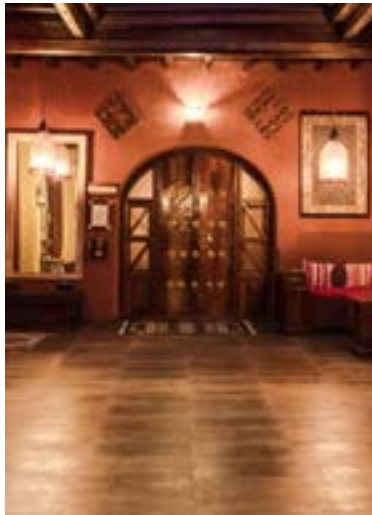

A building over 100 years old, Jafferji House has been passed from generation to generation, finally opening its doors as a guest-house and spa.

Ideally located in the heart of Stone Town, close to all the attractions the historical town has to offer, Jafferji House & Spa is a small, eccentric boutique hotel. The design of the hotel captures the heritage of an era gone by and combines this with modern-day amenities, creating comfort and personalised service with attention to every detail. The suites each have a story to tell and are wonderfully furnished with Zanzibari, Swahili, Omani and Afghani antiques and artefacts.

The rooftop restaurant serves Swahili cuisine, infused with a continental twist that includes many of the spices that Zanzibar is famous for: cumin, cardamom, cinnamon, star anise, turmeric, saffron, cloves and pepper. Ocean-fresh seafood is combined with freshly available produce.
