Description

On our family day in the Peninsula, we start by leaving the city behind, stopping at a scenic location, to enjoy a hot chocolate and to listen to a few of the local shark stories.

Next, we visit the seals at Kalk Bay, exploring this working fishing harbour, perhaps throwing in a fishing line or taking a short stroll through the village. From seals, we move on to their cute neighbours, the penguins. Away from the crowds, we go in search of our own rogue penguins, finding them on a local beach. Dip your feet in the sea water, and possibly try your hand at stand-up paddling to get a different perspective of these little darlings.

All penguined-out we continue on to the Cape Point, where we hunt for the Cape 5 (Ostrich, Baboons, Mountain Zebra, Bontebok and Tortoise) and wander along hiking trails which lead through indigenous fynbos, past hidden coves and rocky beaches. We chat about the shipwrecks on this coastline - keeping an eye out for lost treasure - and either head up the funicular or take a gentle hike to the Cape Point Lighthouse, for an incredible panoramic view over the ocean, and back along the seaboard.

On our return journey, we stop at a local farm village for homemade ice-cream, and either head to the beach or stop at an old fort look-out for magical views.

*Please note that during your morning brief your guide may advise changing the route of your tour to allow for us to beat any pending crowds into certain areas during peak seasons so that we can spend maximum time exploring outside the vehicle.

Explore - Hot Chocolate & Shark Stories



Start the day with an energizing and stimulating stop along the coastline as we take a break from your journey to enjoy some of our onboard delights which could be either hot chocolate, coffee, organic tea or flavoursome juice. With hot-chocolate in hand, make the most of your time to hear about spellbinding shark stories and how the remarkable shark-spotters initiative was developed to

keep our waters safe. All the while enjoying the breath-taking panoramic views of either the cold Atlantic Ocean or the slightly warmer Indian Ocean, before we dive in to explore the rest of the peninsula.

Explore Kalk Bay - Meet the Resident Seals & Fishing Folk



Kalk Bay is loved for its bohemian vibe and fabulous oldstyle architecture surrounding the working harbour at its heart. Take a look around the boatyard, watch the fisherman bringing their day's catch in, or throw a line over the harbour wall with the locals. Seals frequent the safe waters, and out to sea, you could be lucky to spot pods of dolphins and whales cruising past. For arty types, explore

the galleries and enjoy the mix of locally produced street art along the sidewalk. Be sure to take a walk down the side alleys for some unexpected finds.

Explore with Penguins - Family Stand Up Paddle, Kayak or Conservation Walk near Boulders, Simon's Town



Bring the kids to paddle our SUPs or Kayak near the famous penguins of Boulders Beach – an experience that should not be missed if you're exploring the Peninsula. We'll venture away from the main colony and busy walkways and find one of the two coves nearby for some fun in the safe rock pools far from the crowds. Paddle over kelp forests and watch these intriguing seabirds from our

boards. This is real adventure stuff. Those wanting to stay on dry land can experience a conservation penguin walk.

Explore Cape Point - History, Wildlife & Nature



The Cape Point Nature Reserve is filled with adventure, wildlife and captivating historical stories around the Cape of Storms with shipwrecks and legends enchanting this renowned area. We start our journey along one of the lesser travelled roads to search for the Cape Five – ostrich, baboons, bontebok, tortoises and mountain zebra – and whatever else we can find while enjoying the beautiful

views and Cape Fauna Floral. Next, we'll explore further afield and perhaps enjoy a light hike to one of the deserted white beaches or enjoy a short walk along the coastline learning about the fynbos, habitat and biodiversity of the wildlife in the area. All the while your guide will bring to live the history behind the area and perhaps tell a story or two about the mythical ghost ship haunting the southern seas.

Early Evening Family Sundowners - Like a local



End the day with a visit to the Noordhoek Farm Village where the kids can indulge in a handcrafted ice cream, next we'll either head to the beach or stop at an old fort look-out for magical views on Chapman's Peak Drive. Enjoy a Hot Chocolate, Uber Iced Tea or Early Evening G&T at one of our favorite locations. Your guide will make a decision depending on the vibe of the day, to ensure a

really memorable end to the day.
