Description

Up the mountain we go, the cable car revealing the incredible vistas of the city and ocean the higher we climb. On reaching the top, we move away from the crowds, tracking a dassie (local rock rabbit) and breaking for a well-earned hot chocolate and delicious baked goods. Returning to sea level, we hop on our bikes, cycling along the Sea Point Promenade to explore the Atlantic Seaboard, where children lead the exploration with their own interactive maps. Stopping at art installations en-route, we listen to the story of Mandela, whilst gazing out towards Robben Island where he spent so many years imprisoned. Staying safe and off road we head into Green Point Park for a fun insight into the unique Cape flora and fauna before lunch.

Once our energy levels have been replenished, it's time to explore the city's uplifting township-inspired designs at The Watershed, District Six and interactive sites like the Apartheid Benches which bring to life the history which has shaped our nation. (Terrific stuff for teens and older "kids.")

Families with younger kids proceed to Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens for an afternoon of running rampant within the estate. Follow a treasure map which leads between tree-top canopy walkways and prehistoric cycad gardens (complete with dinosaurs). Jump over steppingstones, climb Van Riebeeck's historic hedge and barrel down lawns in search of Claud the Clawless Otter.

Slowing things down, end the day at the beach and, while parents sip sundowners with their feet in the sand, tired, happy kids burn away the last of their energy, making use of our on-board toy box to play beach games with their energetic guide.

Hike Table Mountain the Easy Way - Cable Car & Family Hike to Maclear's Beacon



At the very top of Table Mountain is Maclear's Beacon – the highest point of all. We'll take the cable car both ways and enjoy the views while our guide brings Cape Town's incredible history to life. The kids will enjoy tracking dassies, and will be fascinated by these furry rodents – more so when they learn that these rock rabbits are actually the closest living relatives of the African elephant!

Bike - Family Urban Exploring Sea Point Promenade on Cruiser Bikes



A fun way to explore this lively stretch of the Atlantic Seaboard is to set off on an interactive expedition along the Sea Point Promenade. Hop on a bicycle at the Sea Point Promenade Bike Station, for a relaxed ride along the prom. Here kids can use their interactive map to find local art installations, look out for the Mouille Point Lighthouse and learn about the exciting stories of the ancient strandlopers. After finishing your cycle drop off your bikes at the Silo District in the V&A Waterfront. From here explore the V&A Waterfront including the stylish local crafts and designs at the Watershed, while your guide collects the tour vehicle to continue your adventure.

Explore – Township inspired designs at the Watershed Market



The Watershed Market is a vibrant shopping space with over 150 stalls and over 365 brands including ceramics, textiles, furniture, art and craft, fashion and jewellery. Take a stroll through these multi-coloured stalls and discover beautifully handcrafted artefacts which are locally produced and made by talented artisans throughout South Africa. Many of these artisans are residents in the local townships and use their experiences to create art. Their designs are lovingly crafted to cater to a variety of shoppers with their passion etched into each intricate piece of art.

Hike Kirstenbosch Gardens & Boomslang - Family Tree Top Canopy Hike



Kirstenbosch Gardens is acclaimed as one of the greatest Botanical Gardens in the world, and in March 2015 claimed the Garden of the Year Award at the 2015 International Garden Tourism Awards. The gardens is the perfect setting for anyone with an interest in plants, birds and photography and as you hike through exploring the vast array of flowers with your guide, you will head to the top of the gardens where the Tree Canopy Walkway, or Boomslang is situated. The Boomslang (meaning tree snake) will lead us from the forest floor right up through the trees, offering spectacular panoramic views of the mountains, Garden and City.

End the day with Sundowners at one of our favourite locations –be it an exclusive use of a lifesaving hut, on a quiet slope of Table Mountain, a local's only watering hole or a special look out point/beach. Your guide will make a decision depending on the vibe of the day, to ensure a really memorable end to the day.
