WHERE

Singita Serengeti House is located on Sasakwa Hill within Singita Grumeti Reserves. Singita Grumeti Reserves is located in northern Tanzania and forms part of the Serengeti-Mara ecosystem. The Singita Grumeti Reserves concession spans a vast 340,000 acres. The house has a prime location on the south-east slopes of the hill with an ideal view of a watering hole situated just beyond the house. Singita Serengeti House is 1.5km in distance from Singita Sasakwa Lodge.

GETTING THERE

BY AIR: Sasakwa Airstrip is the gateway to Singita Serengeti House and is located on Singita Grumeti Reserves. Guests can fly to Sasakwa Airstrip with the Tanganyika Flying Company from any of the following airports:

- Nairobi Wilson (Kenya)
- Kilimanjaro (Tanzania)
- Arusha (Tanzania)

Private charters can also be arranged on request from all these airports. Please contact Singita reservations for prices and details of charter flights. The co-ordinates for Sasakwa airstrip are as follows:

WHEN TO GO	ALL YEAR. Singita Grumeti Reserves has various seasons, although game viewing is prolific throughout the year. The lodge is open all year round. June to August is migration season. November has the shorts rains (good grass and game viewing after this) with the longer rain in April.
HOSTS	Graham Ledger is the General Manager of Singita Grumeti Reserves.

There is also children's DVD's, board games and a Nintendo Wii in the house to keep the children entertained.

completely devoid of game. Illegal poaching and uncontrolled legal hunting had resulted in the collapse of the wildlife population. In 2002, the Grumeti Community and Wildlife Conservation Fund was formed: a non-profit organisation dedicated to community-based work, anti-poaching and development. The Grumeti Fund has established a number of schools and sustainable agricultural projects and in just under a decade the Fund team, Singita Grumeti Reserve guests and others have – through their hard work, dedication and donations – helped restore the vast majority of Singita Grumeti Reserves resident wildlife population. Through additional and extensive education efforts and the creation of alternative employment opportunities – for those residing around the Serengeti ecosystem – the groundwork for sustainable conservation, in Singita Grumeti Reserves (and beyond), has been laid.
