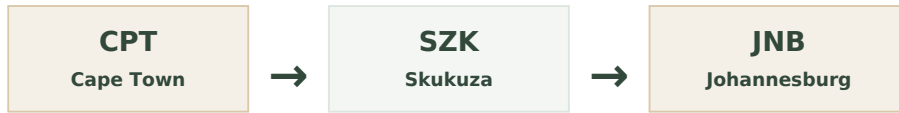


PACKING GUIDELINES - SOUTH AFRICA SAFARI

Baggage information for the scheduled flights included in this itinerary



Your itinerary includes two scheduled flights: Cape Town to Skukuza and Skukuza to Johannesburg. The standard economy baggage allowances for these flights are outlined below.

CHECKED BAGGAGE

- Economy-class allowance: One checked bag weighing up to 20 kg (44 lb) per person.
- Checked-bag dimensions: Up to 90 x 72 x 45 cm (35.4 x 28.3 x 17.7 in.), including wheels, handles and outside pockets, with combined dimensions up to 207 cm.
- Bag construction: Standard hard-sided and soft-sided suitcases are accepted. A soft or semi-soft case is often easier to handle in safari vehicles.
- Bag shape: Use a regular-shaped bag with at least one flat surface. Secure or tuck away long straps and loose handles.

CABIN BAGGAGE

- Economy-class allowance: One cabin bag weighing up to 8 kg (17.6 lb), plus one slimline laptop bag.
- Cabin-bag size: Up to 56 x 36 x 23 cm (22 x 14 x 9 in.), with combined dimensions up to 115 cm.
- Camera equipment, documents, medication and valuables should fit within the cabin allowance. On a full regional flight, cabin bags may be placed in the hold when overhead space is limited.

PRACTICAL PACKING GUIDANCE

- Choose one medium-sized checked suitcase or rolling duffel.
- Laundry service is available at many safari lodges, sometimes included and otherwise available for an additional charge.
- Weigh your checked and cabin bags before departure and leave room for purchases.
- Place identification inside and outside each checked bag, and remove old airline tags.

O.R. TAMBO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

Regular-shaped baggage requirement

The regular-shaped baggage requirement remains in effect. Checked bags must be regular in shape and have at least one flat surface. Secure all straps and handles so the bag moves smoothly through the baggage system.

WHEN THIS APPLIES

The requirement applies whenever you check baggage at Johannesburg O.R. Tambo International Airport, including for an onward international flight after arriving from Skukuza. Use a regular-shaped bag throughout the trip for easy handling at each airport.

A COMPLIANT BAG

- Has at least one flat surface and can travel normally on a conveyor belt.
- Is rectangular or otherwise regular in shape. A standard suitcase, rolling duffel with a flat base, or safari duffel with a structured bottom is suitable.
- Has shoulder straps, compression straps and loose handles fastened securely or tucked inside.
- May be hard-sided or soft-sided, with a regular shape and securely fastened straps.

SMOOTH AIRPORT HANDLING

- Choose a regular-shaped bag with a flat base or flat side.
- Fasten or tuck in shoulder straps, compression straps and loose handles before check-in.
- Keep the packed bag within the stated weight and size allowances.

Best choice for this trip: a medium, regular-shaped suitcase or rolling duffel weighing up to 20 kg when packed, paired with a compact cabin bag weighing up to 8 kg. Hard-shell luggage is acceptable when it has a regular shape and fits within the stated dimensions.
