Power On/Off:	Power on/off button is on the top right of GPS. Press and hold the on/off button for 2 seconds to switch on or off.	Slide the power key to the left.

Charging	The charger input is located at the base of the GPS. Plug this into the cigarette lighter. If your battery is not fully charged, the unit may not operate. If your battery is not fully charged, the unit may not operate. It takes approximately 2 hours to fully charge.
Main Menu	Tap the centre of the screen to open the main menu at any time.	
Resetting the unit	Reset the unit by using a pen or a straightened paper clip to push the reset button which will take a while.	If your GPS stops responding, turn it off and then on again to reset. If this does not help, press and hold the reset button on the bottom of the unit for several seconds. Do not use a sharp object to reset, as this can damage the unit.

- Zoom: To zoom in and out, simply press the + or sign on the top of the coroon
- Several icons are available on Main Menu 1-2, the Change Preference icon allows you to use night colors, show POI on map, turn off sound, change volume, change voice, language, brightness, set clock. The
